Israeli aggression against Global Sumud Flotilla 'terrorism, blatant violation of intl. law'

The Foreign Ministry has vehemently denounced the Israeli regime's aggression against the international Global Sumud Flotilla, an international fleet seeking to break

Tel Aviv's near-total siege of the Gaza Strip.

On Wednesday, the Israeli military in a statement on Thursday, spokesman Esmail Baghaei said

the atrocity represented "a blatant violation of international law and an act of terrorism."

He praised the humanitarian efforts of the flotilla's activists and grassroots groups that hailed from

various countries, saying they had "stood in solidarity with the Palestinian people and sought to break the cruel blockade."

Multiple boats

belonging to the 50-strong fleet of vessels were intercepted earlier by the Israeli navy as they were ap-

proaching the coastal sliver.

An unknown number of activists were placed under arrest and the vessels' communication with the outside world jammed as an effort aimed at preventing the participants' live-streaming of the atrocity.

The aggression took place amid the regime's October 2023-present war of genocide on Gaza that has been using the siege as a means of trying to maximize suffering and casualties. Baghaei noted that the ongoing ethnic cleansing and massacre of innocent civilians in Gaza highlighted the legal,

After a gap of 5 years, India, China to resume direct flight services this month

After a gap of five years, India and China will resume direct flight services by the end of this month as part of efforts to rebuild their ties that came under severe strain following the border standoff in eastern Ladakh. The announcement by the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) came a month after Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chinese President Xi Jinping held talks on the margins of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation's summit in China's Tianjin city.

The flight services between the two sides were suspended following the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020. They were not restored in view of the over four-year border face-off in eastern Ladakh, which ended in October last year. "Since earlier this year, as part of the government's approach towards gradual normalisation of relations between India and China,

the civil aviation authorities of the two countries have been engaged in technical-level discussions on resuming direct air services between the two countries and on a revised air services agreement," the MEA said. It has now been agreed that direct air services connecting designated points in India and China can resume by late October, in keeping with the winter season schedule and subject to commercial decision of the designated carriers from the two countries and fulfilment of all operational criteria, it added.

Taking exception to Prime Minister Narendra Modi hailing the RSS for its role in nation building, AIMIM president Asaduddin Owaisi on Thursday claimed that no RSS member sacrificed his life during the freedom movement or went to jail after its formation, as per his knowledge. Addressing a gathering here, Owaisi claimed, quoting from a biography of RSS founder K B Hedgewar, that the leader participated in the Dandi March in 1930 and went to jail only to encourage freedom fighters to join the Sangh later. Hedgewar's intent was not genuine participation in the freedom

struggle, he alleged. "I was surprised by the claims that the RSS participated in India's freedom struggle. PM Modi has a habit of delivering long speeches. From my reading, no RSS member sacrificed his life or went to jail after its formation," he said. The British archives clearly state that RSS workers never participated in the freedom struggle and posed no threat, he claimed. "Furthermore, the RSS magazine 'Organizer' wrote on August 14, 1947 that the three colours of our national flag were inauspicious. This was known to the PM, but ignored," Owaisi said. When the Constitution was adopted on November 23, 1949, the RSS wrote in 'Organizer'

that they don't need that Constitution, claiming they needed 'Manusmriti' instead, he said. The second Sarsangchalak of RSS M S Golwalkar, in his book 'Bunch of Thoughts', labeled Christians, Muslims, and the Left as internal threats to India, he claimed. The RSS repeatedly doubt India's Muslims, but the first person sent to 'Kala Pani' (Andaman Cellular Jail) was Maulvi Allauddin Rahmatullah from Hyderabad, he claimed. PM Modi on Thursday lauded the annual Vijaydashmi address of RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat as inspiring, and said he highlighted India's innate potential to attain new heights of glory. He said on X, "An inspiring



address by Param Pujya Sarsangchalak Dr. Mohan Bhagwat Ji, highlighting the rich contributions of the RSS to nation-building and emphasising the innate potential of our land to attain new heights of glory, thereby benefiting our entire planet." On the 'I Love Muhammed' campaign row, Owaisi said there is no objection if someone says

"I love Modi", but there is an objection to saying "I love Muhammed". The controversy erupted when the police in Kanpur registered an FIR against 24 people for allegedly installing boards with 'I Love Muhammad' written on them during an Eid-e-Milad-un-Nabi procession on September 4.

Trump's Gaza plan 'Israeli blueprint' to erase Palestinian rights: Yemen's Ansarullah leader

Jaishankar laid wreaths at the Tomb of Unknown Soldier at the Kremlin Wall to pay homage to Soviet people who died in World War II.



The leader of Yemen's Ansarullah resistance movement says US President Donald Trump's plan for the post-war Gaza Strip is in fact an "Israeli blueprint" to erase Palestinian rights and dom-

inate the region. "This plan was first submitted to [Israeli prime minister Benjamin] Netanyahu so that, by adding certain clauses, the full demands of the Zionist regime could be incorporated into

it," Abdul-Malik al-Houthi said in a televised speech on Thursday evening. Trump's plan is aimed at stripping Palestinians of their rights, entrenching Israeli dominance, and turning the region into a Zionist stronghold, he added.

Under the plan, Houthi said, no form of Palestinian sovereignty over Gaza is envisioned, and even the title "State of Palestine" has not been accepted, not even symbolically. The White House announced the plan that purportedly calls for an immediate ceasefire in the Gaza Strip, the exchange of Israeli captives held by Hamas for Palestinians languishing in Israeli prisons, and a phased Israeli with-

drawal from Gaza.

Under the proposal, Hamas would be required to disarm, and the US would work with Arab and international partners to install a so-called "temporary international stabilization force." The plan also stipulates that Hamas would have no role in governing Gaza. Instead, it proposes establishing an administrative committee controlled by the U, the UK, and other countries, excluding even the West Bank-based Palestinian Authority, the Yemeni leader added.

"Israel, in this plan, has demanded the disarmament of the resistance and the expulsion of the fighters from Gaza. These clauses

are part of an effort to turn Gaza into a region devoid of any presence of resistance forces," Houthi warned. Referring to Britain's colonial history in Palestine, the Ansarullah leader said that just as the UK handed Palestine over to the Zionists, the United States is now repeating this pattern. He emphasized that Trump's recognition of al-Quds as the "capital" of the Israeli regime represents one of the gravest crimes committed against the Palestinian people and the broader Islamic nation. He also warned that the US is seeking to involve Arab countries in the Israeli regime's security project.
