Israel shifts frontline deeper into Gaza, strikes hit families trapped inside

Local authorities say the Israeli military has expanded the so-called "yellow line" truce demarcation in Gaza City and repositioned its forces deeper into the territory in violation of a ceasefire agreement that came into force on October 10, besieging dozens of Palestinian families. Gaza's Government Media Office announced in a statement on Thursday that Israeli forces widened the boundary by shifting the markers, and advanced roughly 300 meters (984 feet) into the neighborhoods of Ash-Shaaf, An-Nazzaz and Baghdad Street.The move pushed further into civilian areas, trapping families who were unable to flee as tanks rolled forward, it added.

Russia confirms it's received White House plan on ending war

Lebanon at 'critical phase' as PM says Israel blocking withdrawal talks

ebanon's Prime Minister ■Nawaf Salam says Israel is refusing to enter talks to end its occupation of Lebanese territory, despite last November's ceasefire agreement and the regime's public rhetoric.

Salam said Lebanon's President Joseph Aoun has offered to start talks with Israel to discuss its withdrawal from the five border out-

"I repeat the same offer of negotiating with Israel," Salam said in an interview with Bloomberg on Thursday, noting that Israel declined to respond to the Lebanese offer.

Israel and Hezbollah agreed to a ceasefire agreement that took effect on November 27, 2024. Under the deal, Tel Aviv was required to with-



draw fully from the Lebanese territory-but has kept forces stationed at five sites, in clear violation of UN Security Council Resolution 1701 and the terms of the agreement.

"That's a puzzle for me. They ask for negotiations, and when we show readiness, they don't agree to the rendez-vous," the premier said.

"That's something I'll be bringing

up with the Americans," he added. His remarks came as the pre-

mier's government approved a US proposal to disarm the Hezbollah resistance movement that has for decades defended the country from external aggression, especially from the Israeli enemy.

Hezbollah has condemned the government's decision to disarm it

as a "grave sin," warning that such a move would weaken the country against Israeli aggression. The popular resistance group declared it would ignore the decision entirely, treating it "as if it did not exist."

Referring to the Israeli occupation of the five sites and the regime's ongoing deadly attacks, Lebanese armed forces commander General Rodolphe Haykal said on Friday, "Today, our nation is witnessing a critical phase, one of the most difficult in its history.

He added that the Israeli violations "prevent the army's full deployment, and cause widespread destruction to property and infrastructure." Haykal was scheduled to visit Washington this week, but the visit was canceled over his recent statement condemning Israel for its incessant aggression on the Arab country's south.

leged financed the violence. Citing statements from a witness, Raju submitted that conspirators planned violence, organised chakka jams to disrupt and "choke Assam out of India," and further

mobilised rioters who, armed with sticks, engaged in heavy stone-pelting."This is a clear case where UAPA [Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967] offences are attracted, conspiracy to commit terrorist act, murder, etc is made out. Bengaluru: Signalling that he will continue as the Chief Minister of Karnataka, Siddaramaiah has asserted that he would present his record 17th Budget next year.Siddaramaiah, who also holds the finance portfolio, presented his 16th budget in March. He was speaking at the golden jubilee of LG Havanur on Wednesday, marking submission of the first backward classes commission report. "When I first became finance minister, a newspaper wrote — this Siddaramaiah (a Kuruba) can't count a hundred sheep, how will he function as Karnataka's finance minister — I accepted this as a challenge..... Manchester United Dealt Blow As Benjamin Sesko Ruled Out For Weeks



Star striker Benjamin Sesko will be sidelined 'for a few weeks' because of a knee injury sustained before the international break, manager Ruben Amorim confirmed on Friday.

The forward, who joined United from RB Leipzig for £74 million (\$97 million) in August, got injured during the 2-2 draw at Tottenham on November 8 and missed Slovenia's World Cup qualifiers. Amorim initially expressed greater concern because it involved a knee, but he is now confident the 22-year-old has avoided a lengthy absence.

"He will be out for a few weeks; I don't know exactly how long, but it is not that serious," Amorim said at his pre-match press conference for Monday's game against Everton.

"We need to be cautious with him. He is recovering and feeling better. So, I expect to have Ben (Sesko) back in a few weeks." Amorim anticipates Sesko's return around the same time

that Cameroon's Bryan Mbeumo, Ivory Coast international Amad Diallo, and Morocco's Noussair Mazraoui will depart for the Africa Cup of Nations, which begins in Morocco on December 21.

"We are trying our best to keep the players a bit longer, but it's not entirely in our control," Amorim said"We must respect that, but we will do everything to protect the club, the player, and the national team."When asked about approaching the anniversary of his first game as United manager against Ipswich on November 24 last year, Amorim reflected on the challenges. "From the start, I knew we would face some struggles," he said. "But it's the best league in the world and maybe the best club. It's a big job that requires a lot of effort."Amorim noted that United are showing progress after a difficult 2024/25 season, in which they finished 15th in the Premier League.

INDIA VS PAKISTAN T20 WORLD CUP 2026 MATCH TO BE PLAYED ON...

India hosts the T20 World Cup 2026 and have been grouped with USA, Namibia, Pakistan, and Netherlands. India-Pakistan clash in Colombo on February 15.



The T20 World Cup 2026 is around the corner, with India hosting the mega ICC event for the first time since 2016. Defending champions Team India will begin their campaign against the USA at the Narendra Modi Stadium on February 8.
According to RevSportz, the men in blue have been grouped with Pakistan, Namibia, the Netherlands and the USA. Their marquee clash against Pakistan is likely scheduled

for February 15 in Colombo. The tournament — jointly hosted by India and Sri Lanka — will run from February 7 to March 8, marking the first time the T20 World Cup will be played during the Asian winter.

hospital. Gill was kept under observation before being discharged the following day. He did travel to Guwahati on November 19 but didn't take part in the training sessions before being ruled out. "Unfortunately, he (Gill) was not fully fit to feature in the 2nd Test and will head to Mumbai for further assessment of his injury," read the statement.


