10 foreign spy agencies involved in plot to destabilize Iran: IRGC intelligence

The Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) Intelligence Organization says it has foiled a terrorist plot hatched by spy agencies of 10 foreign countries aimed at fueling chaos and threatening Iran's identity.

In a statement on Monday, the IRGC said the terrorist incidents of recent weeks were part of a major US-Israeli plot to undermine Iran's integrity in terms of its geography and national identity.

"The enemy's command room was formed immediately after the 12-day war with the participation of 10 hostile intelligence services," it said.

The IRGC intelligence arm said the plan was aimed at fomenting internal riots coupled with foreign intervention to pose an existential threat against the Islamic Republic.

It noted that the scheme was defeated thanks to the vigilance of Iranian security forces and the collaboration of the people.

According to the statement, the IRGC Intelligence Organization arrested 735 individuals affiliated with anti-security networks, summoned 11,000 vulnerable people, confiscated 743 unauthorized firearms, and identified 46 individuals linked to foreign services.

Iran says it has filed legal and criminal complaints in international forums against the United States, the Israeli regime, and several terrorist groups for supporting and financing subversive actions against Iran's national security.

The defendants are involved in backing destabilizing activities and acts of sabotage aimed at undermining the country's se-

curity.

Foreign-instigated riots in Iran escalated on January 8 and continued for several days, following peaceful protests in Iranian bazaars and markets where traders called for government action to halt the devaluation of the Iranian rial.

The violence, encouraged openly by

the Israeli regime and US President Donald Trump, resulted in extensive damage to public and private property, with widespread destruction of shops, government institutions, public service facilities, and the killing of thousands of civilians, including women and children, as well as security forces.

Iranian authorities have confirmed that US and Israeli spy agencies were directly involved, providing funding, training, and media support to rioters and armed terrorists acting on the streets.

REPUBLIC DAY : INDIA, EU CONCLUDES NEGOTIATIONS FOR FTA SUCCESSFULLY

The conclusion of talks for the agreement will be announced formally in the India-EU (European Union) Summit here on Tuesday.

India and the European Union (EU) have successfully concluded negotiations for the proposed free trade agreement, which will help boost two-way commerce and strengthen economic ties between the two sides, Commerce Secretary Rajesh

Agrawal said on Monday, January 26. He said the trade deal

from the Indian perspective is balanced and forward-looking, which will help in the better economic integration of India with the EU.

It will propel trade and investments in both economies, he said.

"Negotiations have been successfully concluded. The deal has been finalised," Agrawal said.

Legal scrubbing of the Free Trade Agreement (FTA) text is underway,



and the endeavour will be to complete the processes and sign the pact at an early date, he said.

Implementation of the deal takes time, as it requires approval from the EU Parliament. In India, it requires only the nod of the Union Cabinet.

The pact is finalised after 18 years of negotiations. The talks started in 2007.

Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal has termed this free trade agreement (FTA) "the mother of all deals" that the country has signed so far.
