KTR QUESTIONED BY SIT IN PHONE-TAPPING CASE, INSTRUCTED NOT TO CONTACT WITNESSES

Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president KT Rama Rao, who appeared before the Special Investigation Team (SIT) in the phone tapping case on Friday, January 23, has been instructed not to contact witnesses.

US THREAT TO IRAN'S LEADER WILL IGNITE ENTIRE REGION: HEBBOLLAH

The political wing of the Hezbollah resistance movement in the Lebanese Parliament has warned that the United States' rhetorical threats against Iran and Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei risk escalating tensions in West Asia. In a statement released on Thursday, the Loyalty to the Resistance Bloc raised alarm at Washington's aggressive policies towards regional countries, blasting US President Donald Trump for threatening to annihilate nations and change their governments.

"American aggression against nations and people in our region has reached a level of arrogance, threatening the life of the supreme religious leader of millions of Muslims, Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei," it said.

"This threatens to ignite the entire region, adding to threats against the Iranian people, who have stood firm

against American and Zionist attempts to undermine their security and stability."
