## KTR QUESTIONED BY SIT IN PHONE-TAPPING CASE, INSTRUCTED NOT TO CONTACT WITNESSES

Bharat Rashtira Samithi (BRS) working president KT Rama Rao, who appeared before the Special Investigation Team (SIT) in the phone tapping case on Friday, January 23, has been instructed not to contact witnesses.

The notice to KTR was issued by the Assistant Commissioner of Police P Venkatagiri, who is the investigating officer.

KTR may be summoned again

After appearing before the SIT on Friday, KTR has been informed that he may be summoned again if required.

In a press release, the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, VC Sajjanar mentioned, "It has been noticed that misleading and baseless information is being circulated by certain sections of the media and individuals, claiming that phone interception was done on security grounds and that no illegality was involved. The Investigating Agency is not concerned with such false narratives. The investigation is being conducted strictly in accordance with law, fairly and professionally."

He also instructed the public not to propagate or circulate unverified or misleading information and to rely only on facts placed on record through lawful and official channels.

A right-wing event in Uttar Pradesh's Raebareli came under fire after Hindutva leaders Khushboo Pandey and Riddhima Sharma allegedly targeted Muslims and Christians in a hate speech on Wednesday, January 21.

Addressing the Virat Hindu Conference, Sharma, a social media influencer and content creator who focuses on Hindutva, Sanatan Dharma and political commentary, spoke on the lynching of Bangladeshi Hindu Dipu Chandra



Das, saying, "If they kill two of yours, you kill 100 people in retaliation for peace."

On the conspiracy theory of "love jihad," she said, "Woh aapke ek Hindu ladki ko bhagate hai, toh aap unke 100 ladki ko bhagao (If they

are making one Hindu girl run away, then you should make 100 of their girls run away)."

She insinuated that since the Muslim community "already has a large population," there should be no problem in decreasing the number.

## JUNGLE RAJ HAS ARRIVED: Owaisi on Odisha pastor mob attack

A day after the Odisha pastor attack drew widespread attention, All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) leader Asaduddin Owaisi said the mob attack "is one of several incidents" since the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) formed the government in Odisha.

"Ever since the BJP has formed the government in Odisha, the state's tribals, Muslims and Christians have been targeted continuously. Multiple Bengali Muslim street vendors have been beaten up and threatened," the AIMIM leader said in a post on X.

He claimed that "jungle raj" has taken over the BJP-ruled states, taking Uttar Pradesh as an example and citing the murder of an interfaith couple in Moradabad, the withdrawal of the accused's charges in Akh-



laq's lynching and the transfer of the judge who ordered a first information report (FIR) against police personnel in the Sambhal violence.

"In short 'jungle raj' has arrived. If you want to know what happens next, look at the news from BJP-ruled states, including Uttar Pradesh: a Hindu-Muslim couple was murdered in Moradabad, the govt wanted to withdraw the case against Akhlaq's murderers & a judge who ordered an FIR against police officers connected to the Sambhal violence was transferred," he said.

## MP: Peace prevails at Bhojshala as Hindus perform puja, Muslims offer namaz

Peace prevailed at the disputed 11th-century Bhojshala-Kamal Maula Mosque complex in Madhya Pradesh's Dhar district on Friday, January 23, as Hindus performed puja to mark Basant Panchami festival while Muslims offered prayer (namaz) within the same premises but at a different location.

The puja began in the early hours under heavy security and will continue till sunset.

As per the Supreme Court's directions, Muslims offered prayers at a place



allocated to them between 1 and 3 pm, the district administration said in a release.

No untoward incident or breach of peace was reported, with around 8,000 police and paramilitary forces deployed in the city. As Basant Panchami fell on Friday this year, the Supreme Court on Thurs-

day, January 22, issued a time-sharing formula to prevent potential friction, ruling that the Hindu community will be permitted to perform prayers from sunrise to sunset, and the Muslim side will be allowed to offer namaz between 1 pm and 3 pm.

## US THREAT TO IRAN'S LEADER WILL IGNITE ENTIRE REGION: HEZBOLLAH

The political wing of the Hezbollah resistance movement in the Lebanese Parliament has warned that the United States' rhetorical threats against Iran and Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei risk escalating tensions in West Asia. In a statement released on Thursday, the Loyalty to the Resistance Bloc raised alarm at Washington's aggressive policies towards regional countries, blasting US President Donald Trump for threatening to annihilate nations and change their governments.

"American aggression against nations and people in our region has reached a level of arrogance, threatening the life of the supreme religious leader of millions of Muslims, Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed



Ali Khamenei," it said.

"This threatens to ignite the entire region, adding to threats against the Iranian people, who have stood firm

against American and Zionist attempts to undermine their security and stability."

Some shopkeepers last month staged peaceful pro-

tests in different Iranian cities over economic grievances, which are directly linked to unilateral US sanctions.

The demonstrations, how-

ever, were steered toward violence after public statements by American and Israeli leaders encouraged vandalism and disorder.

## IRAN PROSECUTOR GENERAL REJECTS TRUMP'S CLAIM ON EXECUTIONS AS 'COMPLETELY FALSE'

Iran's Prosecutor General Mohammad Movahe-di Azad dismissed President Donald Trump's claim that he stopped alleged executions in Iran, calling the assertion false and stressing the judiciary's independence from foreign pressure.

Movahe-di Azad said on Friday that the US president

had made the claim after witnessing the swift and decisive reaction of the Iranian people at nationwide rallies on January 12.

Trump claimed last Friday that he had prevented the alleged execution of over 800 people in Iran.

"This is a completely false claim; neither such a number exists, nor has the Judiciary taken such a decision," Movahe-di Azad said.

"The Judiciary is a fully independent institution that does not bow to external pressure," he said, adding that Iran operates under a clear separation of powers and "does not take orders from foreign actors."

Movahe-di Azad also strongly slammed Trump's recent threats against the Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei.

He said such language amounted to a "declaration of full-scale war," warning that any act of aggression would put US interests around the world at risk from supporters of the Islamic Republic of Iran. He added that bases and interests linked to the US "arrogant regime" and the "child-killing Zionist regime" across the world, particularly in the region, could be considered "legitimate targets" in such a scenario.
