MILLIONS READY TO SACRIFICE LIVES FOR IRAN'S LEADER BAHRAIN'S TOP CLERIC SAYS



Bahrain's most senior cleric has warned that millions are prepared to sacrifice their lives for the Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei, amid escalating US rhetoric against Iran and its spiritual and political authority.

Sheikh Issa Qassem stated on Tuesday that Ayatollah Khamenei is a unique leader in the world, distinguished from others by his profound seminary background, spiritual stature, and political leadership."

A leader for whom millions of great men and women in Iran sacrifice their lives and consider his command as the command of religion," Sheikh Qassem said.

He also emphasized that Muslims around the world support Ayatollah Khamenei and his efforts to promote stability

, peace, and brotherhood among all people. The statement came more than a week after US President Donald Trump insulted Ayatollah Khamenei in a series of remarks during

an interview with Politico. This followed Ayatollah Khamenei's January 17 speech in which he stated that Iran holds Trump responsible for aiding and abetting terrorists who orchestrated large-scale riots in the country in early January.

Ayatollah Khamenei said Trump had falsely portrayed terrorist groups as representatives of the Iranian people, calling it "an appalling slander." In his

Tuesday statement, Sheikh Qassem noted that the millions of Iranians who took to the streets across the country on January 13 to condemn the riots demonstrated clear public support for Ayatollah Khamenei against foreign-backed sabotage operations.

He added that no one in Iran would believe Trump's claims of supporting reform in the country, given his endorsement and involvement in a 12-day war of aggression by the Israeli regime in June.



Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Tuesday, January 27, said that with the blessings of saints, a government that fails to uphold the values of Sanatan Dharma would never return to power in the country. Addressing a gathering of the Swaminarayan sect in Gandhinagar, Shah said that followers of various Sanatan traditions waited for a long time after Independence, hoping for a government that would give due importance to Sanatan Dharma and govern as per its principles.

"I am confident that, with the blessings of saints, a government that disappoints followers of the Sanatan Dharma will never come to power again in this country," he said. The event marked 200 years of "Shikshapatri", a sacred code of conduct containing 212 Sanskrit verses written by Bhagwan Swaminarayan in 1826. It serves as a foundational guide for Swaminarayan Sampraday's followers, outlining moral, social, and spiritual principles, including non-violence, purity, diet, and daily duties. Shah said the son of Gujarat, Narendra Modi, has been leading

He said various decisions and initiatives taken by the Modi government over the past

11 years reflected a commitment to India's cultural and spiritual heritage. PM Modi, EU Leaders Hail Landmark India-EU FTA

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi, along with European Council President Antonio Costa and European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen, on Tuesday hailed the successful conclusion of negotiations of the landmark India-EU Free Trade Agreement (FTA).

"This historic deal is a milestone in the India-EU Strategic Partnership that will significantly enhance bilateral trade and investment ties, drive shared prosperity, strengthen resilient and diversified supply chains, and support sustainable and inclusive growth," a joint statement issued after the 16th India-EU Summit co-chaired by the three leaders said. The leaders emphasised the central role of the World Trade Organisation (WTO) in the multilateral trading system and global trade governance and underlined that meaningful, necessary, and comprehensive reform of the WTO is essential to improve its functions so that it is better suited to advance all members' objectives. In the context of global uncertainty and disruptions, closer economic ties between India and the EU are more important than ever to drive growth, job creation, green transition, industrial development, and more resilient, sustainable and trustworthy supply chains, the statement said.

New Delhi: The traditional Halwa ceremony, which marks the final stage of preparations for the Union Budget 2026-27, was held on Tuesday at the Budget Press in North Block. The ceremony took place in the presence of Union Finance and Corporate Affairs Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and Union Minister of State for Finance Pankaj Chaudhary. The Halwa ceremony is an important ritual that signals the beginning of the 'lock-in'

period for officials involved in preparing the Budget. Once the ceremony is completed, these officials remain cut off from outside contact to ensure complete confidentiality until the Budget is presented. During the ceremony, the Finance Minister was joined by secretaries of various departments under the Ministry of Finance and other senior officials associated with the Budget-making process.

Gamosa controversy: BJP wants to destroy Rahul's image, claims Kharage

The Congress President said Gandhi and he were wearing the 'Gamosa' and took it off while eating and kept it on the table.



Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Tuesday, January 27, slammed the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) over the 'Gamosa' controversy involving Rahul Gandhi and said the ruling party wants to "destroy Gandhi's image through false propaganda" but will never succeed. Kharge also claimed that the Modi government insulted Gandhi, the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, and him by seating him in the third row alongside ministers of state during

the Republic Day parade. A political row erupted over Gandhi allegedly not wearing an Assamese 'Gamosa' given to all the guests at the reception hosted by President Droupadi Murmu on Re-

public Day, with the BJP alleging that the Congress leader insulted the country's Northeast. The BJP also accused Gandhi of showing disregard for President Murmu by not wearing the 'Gamosa' while the Congress countered by pointing out that Defence Minister Rajnath Singh had also not worn the 'patka' (scarf). Gandhi is the only leader who met all the Northeast artists, shook hands with them and also hugged an artist from Arunachal; photographs for this are available," he said. "These people want to destroy Rahul Gandhi's image through false propaganda, but they will never succeed. I am an eyewitness," Kharge asserted.
