

Complaint Filed Against Cleric for Allegedly Threatening Journalist; Police Facilitate Amicable Settlement

A complaint was lodged at the Mir Chowk Police Station yesterday against Ammar Hyderabad for allegedly threatening a journalist over the phone. Acting promptly on the complaint, the police summoned Ammar Hyderabad for inquiry. During the inquiry, Ammar Hyderabad stated that journalist Baqar Ali had used inappropriate language against him in a post, including objectionable

words such as "Netla Nandu" In response, Baqar Ali clarified that his post was of a general nature and did not mention any individual by name. It was also noted that Ammar Hyderabad had posted an inappropriate comment on Baqar Ali's report. The Mir Chowk Police conducted counseling for both parties and directed them to delete the posts. They were advised to maintain mutual respect. Following the police counseling, both sides agreed to respect each other, and the matter was amicably resolved.
