LEADER THANKS IRANIANS FOR DISAPPOINTING ENEMIES WITH MULTIMILLION RALLIES

Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei has praised the Iranian people for a massive nationwide turnout during the Islamic Revolution anniversary rallies, saying the demonstrations left the enemies disappointed.

"On 22 Bahman (February 11) this year, you accomplished a great deed; you brought honor

to Iran," Ayatollah Khamenei said in a televised message delivered Thursday evening.

"As always, by supporting the Islamic Republic you increased its strength, and the enemies who, in their statements and plans, sought the surrender of the Iranian nation became disappointed," he added.

He described the reward of this great public movement as greater dignity, stronger authority, and fuller independence for Iran, adding: "Let us all strive to preserve this connection and national cohesion, which is very valuable and precious."

Ayatollah Khamenei praised the people's presence in the streets and their unified slogans, saying they demonstrated their identity and character to adversaries.

"I thank the entire Iranian nation and extend my abundant

greetings to each and every person present at this great, million-strong gathering across the country," the Leader said.

Tens of millions of Iranians poured into the streets across the country on Wednesday, marking the 47th anniversary of the victory of the Islamic Revolution with one of the largest nationwide turnouts in recent years.

From Tehran to more than 1,400 cities, towns and villages, vast crowds gathered despite forecasts of rain and snow, presenting a sweeping display of unity following months of military confrontation, riots and intensified foreign pressure.

The 2026 anniversary came in the aftermath of a 12-day imposed war in June 2025, during which Israel, backed by the United States, launched attacks against Iranian interests.





Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy on Thursday, February 12, met Defence Minister Rajnath Singh in the national capital and discussed the upcoming Gandhi Sarovar Project, which is being undertaken as part of the prestigious Musi River Rejuvenation initiative.

The Chief Minister formally invited the Defence Minister to attend the foundation stone laying ceremony of the Gandhi Sarovar Project, scheduled to be held in the last week of February, noting that the programme will take place at the sacred confluence of the Esa and Musi rivers.



Rejuvenation Project aimed at ecological restoration and sustainable development.

He further shared the government's vision to develop Bapu Ghat into a world-

class educational, cultural, spiritual, and environmental landmark, reflecting the ideals and legacy of Mahatma Gandhi.

The Defence Minister appreciated the initiative and the efforts being undertaken by the state government, according to the CMO statement.

Congress MPs Mallu Ravi, Kadiyam Kavya, Anil Kumar Yadav, and Vamsi Gaddam accompanied the Chief Minister during the meeting.

During his previous meeting with the Defence Minister in September last year, Revanth Reddy had requested him to transfer 98.20 acres of defence land for the Gandhi Sarovar Project.

Minister Announces 44,706 Accreditation Cards; Revised G.O. Issued



The Minister has issued detailed instructions for the constitution of the Accreditation Committee and the issuance of accreditation cards, directing officials to complete the process in a transparent, efficient and time-bound manner.

He said the government had earlier issued G.O. No. 252 for granting accreditation cards. However, following meetings with various journalists' associations and a comprehensive review of their representations and demands, the government introduced

necessary amendments and issued revised G.O. No. 103.

With these revisions, a total of 44,706 accreditation cards will now be allocated to journalists across the state, covering print, electronic and digital media. Previously, around 23,000 journalists held accreditation cards. The latest decision will add more than 21,000 new cards, significantly expanding coverage and eligibility.

Under the category-wise distribution, the majority of cards have been allotted to the print media sector, followed by satellite channels, local cable networks, national channels, periodicals, news agencies and digital platforms.


In terms of level-wise allocation, 16,056 cards will be issued at the state and district levels, while 28,650 cards will be distributed at the Assembly constituency and mandal levels.

The Minister emphasized that the issuance of accreditation cards will remain a continuous process, and further cards will be sanctioned in the future based on requirements.

The al-Qassam Brigades, the military wing of the Palestinian resistance group Hamas, has warned that any aggression against Iran is tantamount to an attack on the entire Islamic Ummah.

Qassam spokesman Abu Obeida declared support for Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei, as well as the Iranian people and government, in a statement on Wednesday, when the country marked the 47th anniversary of its Islamic Revolution amid recent

provocations and threats by the US and Israel.

"We consider any aggression against the Islamic Republic and its brotherly people to be an aggression against our Islamic nation, a criminal infringement on the sovereignty of a resistant Islamic state," Abu Obeida said.

He also rejected efforts aimed at interfering in Iran's domestic affairs through "brute force" and further denounced the latest threats and previous attacks against Iran as a "desperate" act of "revenge" against the nation, which has stood alongside Palestinians and supported their resistance against the Israeli occupation.

Meanwhile, Abu Obeida expressed confidence in the capabilities of the Iranian Armed Forces, including the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC), to repel any attack, defend the country, and deal harsh blows to the aggressors.
