Iran will respond to Trump's 'delirious threats' on battlefield: Pezeshkian



Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian says Tehran will give a decisive response to "delirious threats" made against it on the battlefield.

Pezeshkian made the remark in a post on his X account on Sunday after US President Donald Trump threatened to attack Iran's power plants if the country does not "fully open, without threat, the Strait of Hormuz, within 48 hours." In response to a scathing report by The New York Times, a frustrated Trump claimed that the US has "blown Iran off of the map" and that he has achieved all his goals in the war "weeks ahead of schedule." "The illusion of erasing Iran from the map shows desperation against the will of a history-making nation," Pezeshkian wrote. The Iranian president added that threats and terror will only strengthen national unity. "The Strait of Hormuz is open to all except those who violate our soil. We firmly confront delirious threats on the battlefield," he emphasized.

Iran says 210 children killed, 300 medical centers damaged in US-Israeli attacks



Iran's minister of health says at least 210 children have lost their lives, and over 1,510 have been injured in US-Israeli attacks across the country. Mohammadteza Zafarqandi made the remarks during a press briefing on the sidelines of a visit to a hospital in Tehran on Sunday, noting that the impact of the aggression extends far beyond the battlefield, affecting civilians, especially women and children, who are caught in the crossfire. He further reported that nearly 300 medical facilities, including hospitals and emergency centers, have suffered significant damage since the war began on February 28. About 30 ambulances have also been damaged and lifesaving services are severely compromised, he added. Zafarqandi further decried the attacks on healthcare facilities, referencing a statement from Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, the head of the World Health Organization (WHO). In a tweet, Ghebreyesus had labeled the assault on the Minab school in southern Iran as a crime against humanity, emphasizing that these incidents cannot be dismissed as mere miscalculations. He paid tribute to the 23 healthcare professionals who have died while providing care during this tumultuous time.

IRAN WARNS Will completely shut STRAIT OF HORMUZ IF POWER PLANTS ATTACKED

Iran's highest operational command unit has warned that the Islamic Republic will completely close the Strait of Hormuz if its electricity generation infrastructure comes under attack.

Spokesman for the Khatam al-Anbiya Central Headquarters Lieutenant Colonel Ebrahim Zolfaqari issued the warning on Sunday in response to US President Donald Trump's threat to attack Iran's power plants if the country does not "fully open, without threat, the Strait of Hormuz, within 48 hours."

Zolfaqari said Iran would take "immediate punitive" measures if the country's fuel and energy infrastructure is attacked. "We have repeatedly declared that the Strait of Hormuz is closed only to



the enemy and harmful passage and has not been yet closed completely and is under our smart control."

"Non-harmful transit continues under specific regulations which guarantee our security and interests," he added.

The spokesman emphasized that if threats against Iranian power plants are implemented, Iran would completely close the

Strait of Hormuz and would keep it closed until the damaged facilities are reconstructed.

He said all Israel's electricity generation plants, energy infrastructure and systems of information and communication technology (ICT) would be targeted.

Iran will also obliterate all similar companies with American shareholders in the region, he noted. Zolfaqari further warned

that power plants in regional countries hosting American bases would also be considered legitimate targets for Iran.

The spokesman reiterated that the armed forces are prepared to "completely destroy all the US economic interests in the West Asia region."

He once again affirmed that Iran did not start the war and would not initiate further escalation, but if the enemy inflicts damage on the country's power plants, Iran would not hesitate to defend national interests.

He cautioned that the "non-stop" measures to destroy the enemies' targets would begin if Iran's power plants are attacked.

"Nothing can prevent us from proceeding with our operation to demolish energy and oil infrastructure and industry of the US and its allies in the region," Zolfaqari asserted.

PROTEST RALLY ANNOUNCED AGAINST US-ISRAEL ATROCITIES ON IRAN

The Committee Against War has announced that a protest rally will be held on 29 March 2026 in Hyderabad, from Charminar to Exhibition Grounds, against the war imposed on Iran by the United States and Israel. Enemy fighter jet operations over central Iran reduce sharply after F-35 strike: Source

Iranian air defense systems have successfully reduced military aggression by American and Israeli fighter jets in the central regions of

the country after the F-35 aircraft was struck, a highly-placed intelligence source told Press TV.

According to the source, Iran's advanced and integrated air defense network has inflicted multiple blows against enemy invading aircraft, forcing a decrease in the tempo of operations over central Iran. "The multiple strikes by Iran's integrated air defense system against American and Israeli invading aircraft have led to a significant reduction in military operations by American and Israeli fighter jets in the central regions of the country," the source said. The source further noted that the enemy had focused on harassment and terrorist actions in central Iran but has so far failed to achieve its objectives. "After striking the F-35, the pace of military operations has decreased, although aircraft and drones are still being used for reconnaissance purposes," he added.

Iran missile attack near Israeli nuclear plant, 200 injured

JERUSALEM/CAIRO Nearly 200 people were injured, 11 of them seriously, in Iranian attacks on Israel's Dimona and Ard areas, Israeli air defenses were unable to intercept at least two Iranian ballistic missiles. Local media reported this on Sunday. Following the Iranian attacks, Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu and the Chief of Staff of the Israeli Defense Forces, Lieutenant General Eyal Zamir, announced that Israel would continue to fight the Iranian enemies on all fronts. The IDF later said that the Israeli Air Force was carrying out strikes on Tehran to target Iranian infrastructure. According to the AP, US President Donald Trump has warned that the United States will wipe out Iranian power plants if the Islamic Republic of Iran does not fully open the Strait of Hormuz within 48 hours. Meanwhile, Iranian missiles hit two cities near Israel's main nuclear research center. Several people were injured and apartment buildings were damaged. The development signals a dangerous new direction in the Middle East war, now in its fourth week.



Telangana to release Rs 9,000 Cr Rythu Bharosa funds in the next 45 days

"Within 45 days from now Rs 9,000 crore in Rythu Bharosa funds will be credited to 70 lakh farmers," the CM said.

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy on Sunday, March 22, assured that Rs 9,000 crore under the 'Rythu Bharosa' investment support scheme will be credited in three instalments to 70 lakh farmers within 45 days.

Reddy released the first instalment of Rythu Bharosa benefit while inaugurating the Oil Palm factory at Narmetta in Siddipet. He said the Congress government has been spending an average of Rs 5,500 crore for farmers' welfare, compared to Rs 2,700 crore during the previous BRS regime. "Within 45 days from now,



Rs 9,000 crore in Rythu Bharosa funds will be credited to 70 lakh farmers," he said.

The CM said the first tranche of payment, Rs 3600 crore, will be completed the following day, another Rs 5,400 crore will be released in the next 20 days, and the rest will be credited

in another 20 days from then. He said that his government is committed to promoting the oil palm industry in the state. He said plans to purchase 10 lakh acres of land are in the pipeline, starting with a processing plant in Kodangal constituency.

'Maniacal tyrant': Trump's threat to attack Iran's power plants sparks fierce backlash

In a dramatic escalation of rhetoric, US President Donald Trump on Sunday issued a 48-hour ultimatum to Iran, threatening to "obliterate" the country's power plants unless the Strait of Hormuz is fully opened for energy traffic. The threat, posted on his social media platform Truth Social and amplified by the White House account, has drawn swift and fierce condemnation from lawmakers, legal experts, and military analysts, describing it as a move that is illegal, strategically incoherent, and indicative of a leader losing control of a war he started.
