Iranians have taken to the streets in cities and towns across the country to pledge their allegiance to the newly appointed Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah


The rallies are underway on Monday in the capital, Tehran, as well as other major cities, including Shiraz, Kerman, Ahvaz, Tabriz, Hamedan, Ardabil, and beyond.

In Tehran, the rally is being held at Enqelab Square, where

participants were seen waving the Iranian national flag and chanting slogans such as "Death to the US" and "Death to Israel."

Participants who spoke to Press TV said they had gathered to reaffirm their loyalty and allegiance to the new Leader of the Islamic Revolution, vowing their full support to him.

### Putin congratulates Iran on election of Ayatollah Mojtaba Khamenei as new Leader



Russian President Vladimir Putin has extended his congratulations to Ayatollah Seyyed Mojtaba Hosseini Khamenei over his election as new Leader of the Islamic Revolution. In a congratulatory message on Monday, Putin expressed confidence that the new Leader would continue his father's work "honorably" and would unite the Iranian people in the face of severe trials. "Now, when Iran is confronting armed aggression, your work in this high office will undoubtedly require great courage and dedication," Putin was quoted by the Kremlin as saying. The Russian president reaffirmed Moscow's "unwavering" support for Tehran and solidarity with its friends in Iran. Iran's Assembly of Experts, a body of 88 clerics, on Sunday night officially appointed Mojtaba Khamenei, 56, as the new and third Leader of the Islamic Revolution of the Islamic Republic of Iran. He is the son of Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei, who was martyred in US-Israeli terrorist attacks on February 28. Iranian officials, state institutions, armed forces, and people from across the country pledged allegiance to the new Leader on Monday.

### Ready to build homes in Old City of for Musi evictees, says CM

The state government is preparing constructive plans to build houses for the displaced poor under the Musi Rejuvenation Project in the Old City of Hyderabad, said Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy on Sunday, March 8. He also appealed to AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi to support the government in the Musi project and the ongoing Metro Rail works as well.

Speaking during inauguration of the restored Bum Rukn-Ud-Dowla lake in the Old City of Hyderabad, Revanth Reddy said there is no shortage of funds for the Metro



rail for the new line being build there. He stated that land acquisition for road development network and of the Metro Rail.

He also said that a "lake economy" is being created in Hyderabad for employments opportunities in the Old City. The Telangana CM also stated that this

will help with more employment opportunities in Hyderabad, and that the state government is working with dedication to restore the encroached ponds, canals and parks.

"We have dealt strictly and restored the famous Bathukamma Kunta lake where women and chil-

dren enjoy natural beauty," he said, according to a press release from his office. Highlighting the importance of the Musi Rejuvenation Project, the CM said that the government is on course to develop Hyderabad and compete with the world.

### Election of new Leader shows will of Iranians for governance: Pezeshkian

Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian says the "valuable" election of Ayatollah Seyyed Mojtaba Hosseini Khamenei as new Leader of the Islamic Revolution is a manifestation of the people's will for governance.

"The country's problems can be solved with his wise leadership and by creating an atmosphere based on trust and participation of the people," Pezeshkian said in a post on his X account on Monday.

He wished success for

the new Leader in preserving the sacred unity and building a progressive and independent Iran. The 88-member Assembly of Experts on Sunday elected Ayatollah Seyyed Mojtaba Khamenei as the successor to his late father Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei, who was assassinated in a US-Israeli terrorist strike on Tehran on February 28-- the first day of the ongoing military aggression against Iran. In a message earlier on Monday, Pezeshkian felicitated Ayatollah Mojtaba Khamenei following his election as the new Leader, saying his appointment heralded "a new era of honor and authority for the Iranian nation." The Iranian president called the election "the embodiment of the will of the Islamic Ummah in strengthening national unity," describing this unity as "an impregnable fortress" that makes the Iranian nation resilient against adversarial plots.

### IRAN WILL DEFINITELY WIN, 113 KILLED IN 2 US MILITARY BASES, INTERVIEW WITH RUSSIAN MILITARY EXPERT

Russian military expert Vladimir Yevseyev said in a conversation with a correspondent of Islamic Republic News Agency (IRNA) that, according to credible Turkish sources,

in the early days of the war Iranian missile and drone attacks on two U.S. military bases in the United Arab Emirates and Kuwait resulted in the deaths of 113 soldiers

and injuries to 200 others. The Russian military expert stated that the Iranian nation is currently facing a major aggression by the United States, Israel, and their allies.

### 30th Wave of Operation Promised Sadiq 4 Marks Start of Mojtaba Khamenei's Leadership

The Public Relations Department of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps announced on Monday morning that on the night of the 19th of Ramadan, with the beginning of the leadership of Iran's new Supreme Leader and with the sacred code words "Ali Wali Allah," the 30th wave of Operation True Promise 4 was launched. According to the statement, missiles and drone aircraft—including Khorramshahr, Fattah, Khyber, and Qadr-type missiles—were used to strike bases of American terrorists in the region as well as centers of the Zionist regime in northern occupied Palestine. Earlier, during the 29th wave of Operation True Promise 4, the Aerospace Division of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps had carried out attacks with advanced missiles on targets in Tel Aviv, the Negev Desert, and U.S. terrorist air bases in the region.



### Three youths allege torture at Raidurgam police station in Hyd

According to MBT party spokesperson, Amjed Ullah Khan, on Saturday night at around 12:20 am, Mohammed Fazal Ur Rahman Akeef, 20 years, was standing along with his friend Abdul Rahman near T-Hub, opposite Niloufer Cafe, when a policeman approached them and slapped Fazal Ur Rahman Akeef without any provocation and snatched the keys of his two-wheeler. When Fazal Ur Rahman Akeef started taking photographs with his mobile phone camera and asked the policeman why he was slapped, another police personnel snatched his mobile phone.
