

YEMEN HITS SENSITIVE ISRAELI TARGETS IN THIRD STRIKE SINCE JOINING IRAN-LED RESISTANCE



Yemeni armed forces have conducted their third round of strikes against Israeli targets in the occupied territories, targeting sensitive locations. "With Allah's help and reliance upon Allah, we carried out the third military operation in the 'Holy Jihad Battle,' targeting sensitive Israeli enemy targets in the southern occupied Palestine with a barrage of ballistic missiles," they said in a statement Wednesday. The operation was conducted jointly with Iranian armed forces and the Lebanese resistance movement Hezbollah, and successfully achieved its objectives, it said. "Yemeni armed forces affirm that the enemy's escalation of its aggression, crimes, and attacks against Lebanon, Iran, Iraq, and Palestine will only drive ... Yemen to further escalation in the coming period until the aggression stops and the blockade is lifted." The Yemeni armed forces officially joined the war against the US and Israel in support of the Islamic Republic of Iran and the resistance front in Lebanon, Iraq, and Palestine on Saturday. CONTINUE SUPPORTING RESISTANCE AGAINST AMERICAN-ZIONIST ENEMY: LEADER TELLS HEZBOLLAH

Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Mojtaba Khamenei has written to Hezbollah's Secretary-General Sheikh Naim Qassem, pledging the Islamic Republic's sustained support for the resistance in the face of the American-Zionist enemy.

The Islamic Republic's policy continues to rest in "ongoing support for the resistance against the Zionist and American adversary," Hezbollah said, citing the message forwarded by Ayatollah Mojtaba Khamenei to Sheikh Qassem.

The Leader noted in the message that such policy was founded upon the path



led by the martyred Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei and Hezbollah's martyred secretary-general, Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah.

In the message, Ayatollah Mojtaba Khamenei emphasized that "standing firm and steadfast in the face of the fiercest enemies of the Islamic Ummah (Nation), namely the United States and the Zionist regime, was among the most outstanding characteristics of the martyred Imam," referring to Ayatollah Khamenei. The

Leader also referred to the continuation of the path of resistance throughout the years of leadership under the martyred Leader, and cited esteemed martyrs such as General Qassem Soleimani, Iran's former top anti-terror commander, and other martyrs hailing from the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) and the Islamic Republic's Army as proof of the veracity of this path.

The Leader further stressed that "the history of the Islamic Resistance is replete with struggle, courage, and sacrifice, where resistance leaders gave their lives in defense of the Ummah without fearing any threat."

US-Israeli strikes hit over 115,000 civilian structures in Iran:

The Iranian Red Crescent Society (IRCS) says the US-Israeli airstrikes have damaged or destroyed more than 115,000 civilian structures across the country over the past five weeks. In a statement released on Wednesday, the organization said since the US and Israel launched their war on Iran last month, "115,193 civilian units, including 91,498 homes and 22,580 commercial facilities, have suffered severe damage or been completely destroyed." In Tehran Province alone, the IRCS said over 44,000 residential buildings and business units were targeted. More than 300 health and medical facilities have also been hit, in a blatant violation of international laws.

Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy on Wednesday, April 1, urged the people of Kerala not to vote for the Liberal Democratic Front (LDF), adding that CM Pinarayi Vijayan is a shadow of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He remarked while beginning a two-day campaign for Congress ahead of Kerala Assembly elections on April 9.



As part of the campaign, Reddy held a road show in Nemon constituency, where he cautioned voters against voting for Liberal

Democratic Front alleging that a vote for LDF would mean a vote for the Bharatiya Janata Party. "Today, I wanted to appeal to people

of Kerala that if you are going to vote for LDF or Pinarayi Vijayan, then your vote is going to reach Narendra Modi in Delhi. ... 100+ heavy missiles, drones fired at enemy positions in wave 89 of retaliation: IRGC

Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) says it has fired more than 100 heavy missiles and attack drones along with 200 rockets across a radius of tens of thousands of kilometers, targeting American and Zionist positions throughout the occupied territories and the wider West Asia region. The coordinated operations were executed on Wednesday in conjunction with other Iranian armed forces and resistance fronts. According to the IRGC Public Relations Department, strikes targeted military objectives and terrorist forces of the Zionist regime in Eilat, Tel Aviv, and Bnei Brak, with local sources reporting heavy Zionist casualties. In continuation of the operation, a hideout of American terrorist army forces in Bahrain, where 80 personnel were stationed, was precisely targeted, said the statement. Additionally, a helicopter group of the US army at the Al-Udayay base was struck by ballistic missiles, resulting in the destruction of one helicopter and severe damage to others, it added. The statement said the latest wave of attacks will continue with further strikes today. Strategic gains of the imposed war

The IRGC statement highlighted the achievements of the imposed war on Iran for the Islamic world, underscoring the unification of the Islamic Ummah under a single banner, achieved through the integration and coordination of resistance fronts against the unjust enemies of the Muslim world, along with the rock-solid cohesion of the Iranian nation.

FM SAYS IRAN HAS 'ZERO' TRUST IN US, DISMISSES EFFICACY OF AMERICAN GROUND ATTACK

Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi has said that Iran has "zero" trust in the United States and dismissed the effectiveness of any potential American ground operation targeting the Islamic Republic.



Speaking in an interview with Al Jazeera, the top diplomat said messages had been exchanged with the United States, either directly or via regional intermediaries, but stressed that these contacts did not constitute negotiations. "I receive messages fom [US envoy

Steve] Witkoff directly, as before, and this does not mean that we are in negotiations," he said, according to remarks published by the network on Tuesday. "There is no truth to the claim of negotiations with any party in Iran," he added, categorically rejecting American

officials' claims of being engaged in such process with Iranian authorities. Araghchi pointed to historical experience as a reason for Iran's distrust. "We do not have any faith that negotiations with the US will yield any results. The trust level is at zero. We don't see honesty," the official stated. As a case in point, he cited the US's withdrawal during Donald Trump's former tenure as president from a 2015 nuclear deal with Iran and others. He also pointed to the Islamic Republic's having entered diplomatic engagement with the US twice over the past year, noting how both processes were interrupted by American aggression. Araghchi clarified that Tehran had not responded to a 15-point proposal sent by the US, nor had it submitted any proposals or conditions of its own. He also dismissed the notion of plurality or multiple decision-making centers in Iran as alleged

BJP's Information Technology Cell Chief and the party's central observer for West Bengal, Amit Malviya, issued a social media statement where he launched a scathing attack against Trinamool Congress and the Chief Minister on both issues.

"The Trinamool has a problem with Bengalis and Hindu Bengalis in particular. Yesterday, they called Leander Paes, a son of the soil, an outsider, forcing him to underline that he is proud to be a descendant of Michael Madhusudan Dutt, a true nationalist who made immense contributions to Bengali and Indian literature," Malviya observed on the Leander Paes issue. "Now, none less than the Chief Minister is writing to the Election Commission, questioning the efforts of Bengalis to appeal the deletion of their names from the voter list as unconstitutional.
