Religious circles often remained confined to speeches and sermons, while journalism, research, writing, and intellectual development were not given equal importance. Some individuals only desired publicity and photographs, yet meaningful support for the institution and the cause remained absent. Despite all these circumstances, the caravan of "Sada-e-Hussain" neither stopped nor bowed down.

However, the common people always showered us with love, trust, and respect. They expressed confidence in our voice, believed in our message, and encouraged us at every stage. For this affection and support, we remain deeply grateful. It was this public trust and love that became the true strength behind our struggle and kept this mission alive.

On the other hand, some individuals — including certain self-proclaimed religious figures — became jealous of our growing popularity and public acceptance, and turned towards hostility and opposition. Attempts were made to involve us in false cases, to assassinate our character, and to disgrace us publicly. Yet time itself proved that truth cannot be silenced. Those who chose the path of falsehood, injustice, and defamation eventually faced humiliation and disgrace themselves.

It is also an unfortunate reality that several NGOs and organizations collected crores of rupees in the name of welfare and education, yet failed to present transparent audit reports and financial details before the community. Public donations and trust demand accountability and transparency, because institutions that collect funds in the name of the people are also responsible to answer before the people.

Despite all these challenges, "Sada-e-Hussain" continued its journey with dignity, self-respect, and intellectual independence. We never practiced journalism to serve the interests of the powerful. Instead, we tried to become the voice of the oppressed, the deprived, and the ordinary people. This has been our mission, our identity, and God willing, it will remain our path in the future as well.

This continued journey is the result of the blessings associated with this name, devotion to the values of Ahlul Bayt (A.S.), and a firm commitment to the path of truth and freedom. No matter how difficult the circumstances become, "Sada-e-Hussain" will continue to fulfill its responsibility. Whether through the Urdu daily or the English weekly, this institution will continue to represent the community, raise the voice of the oppressed, and carry forward the message of truth and justice.

PEZESHKIAN US, ISRAEL USING 'DIVISIVE PROJECTS' TO TURN MUSLIMS AGAINST EACH OTHER

Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian says the United States and Israeli regime are attempting to pursue divisive projects and cause distrust to pit Muslim countries against one another.

In a meeting with Pakistan's Interior Minister Mohsin Naqvi in Tehran on Sunday, Pezeshkian said Iran's principled policy is based on the expansion of friendly ties with neighboring countries, particularly the Persian Gulf littoral states. "The Islamic Republic of Iran seeks cordial, sta-

ble, and sustainable relations based on good neighborliness with the Muslim countries of the region, but the United States and the Zionist regime (Israel) have always attempted, through divisive projects and the creation of distrust, to pit Muslim countries against one another," he added.

He expressed appreciation for Pakistan's role in mediating a ceasefire agreement between Tehran and Washington 40 days after the US-Israeli war of aggression against Iran. He hoped that these diplomatic and political efforts would strengthen peace, stability, and enduring security in the region.

WHY IS PM MODI SILENT? He should apologise to students: Rahul on paper leak

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Sunday, May 17, slammed Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan for "failing" students across age groups amid the NEET-UG paper leak row and CBSE evaluation concerns, and sought an apology from Prime Minister Naren-

dra Modi for "destroying" the future of lakhs of children.

The leader of the opposition in the Lok Sabha also attacked Pradhan over the rollout of the CBSE's three-language policy in schools.

Questioning the "silence" of Prime Minister Modi on these issues, Gandhi asked him why he was not sacking Pradhan despite repeated paper leaks during his tenure.

"First, the NEET paper leak affecting 22 lakh students. Then, CBSE Class 12 students received unexpectedly low marks from a broken OSM system — many losing their college eligibility.

Asaduddin Owaisi urges Telangana govt to postpone OU exams falling on Eid day

Hyderabad: All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) chief and Hyderabad MP Asaduddin Owaisi has appealed to the Telangana government to defer several Osmania University (OU) degree examinations scheduled for Thursday, May 28, as they coincide with Eid al-Adha. In a post on X on Sunday, May 17, Owaisi urged Telangana Chief Minister Anumula Revanth Reddy and chief secretary Shanti Kumari to announce alternative dates for the examinations. He said students observing the festival could face difficulties if the examinations are conducted on Eid day. The examinations listed in his appeal include BCom fourth semester Business Statistics, BCom sixth semester Accounting Standards and Corporate Governance, BSc Honours fourth semester Computer Science (Big Data), BSc Honours sixth semester Optimization Techniques, BSc Biomedical Science fourth semester, BA (CBCS) sixth semester Mathematics and BSW (CBCS) fourth semester Social Work Methodology III.

Hyderabad: Union Minister for Coal and Mines G Kishan Reddy on Sunday said that the names of any Rohingyas or Bangladeshis should be removed from the voters' list during the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process. Addressing a press conference, Reddy said that, except for Indian citizens, the names of other nationals should be removed from the electoral rolls. He assured that BJP booth-level agents would extend full support to Election Commission officials involved in the SIR process to ensure that any non-Indian whose name appears in the voters' list is removed.

TELANGANA RELEASES 221.24 Cr FOR GURUKULS, HOSTELS

Telangana Government released ₹221.24 crore for Gurukul and hostel schools and introduced monthly payments for diet charges, cosmetics and building rents.

The Telangana Government has released ₹221.24 crore for Gurukuls and government residential hostel schools and introduced a monthly payment system for building rent, diet charges and cosmetics expenses. The decision aims to permanently resolve financial difficulties faced by residential educational institutions functioning under SC, ST, BC, Minority Welfare and Education Departments.

Deputy Chief Minister and Finance Minister Bhatti Vikramarka said the government is committed



to providing quality education and better residential facilities for socially backward and weaker section students.

The Telangana Government announced that food expenses (diet charges), cosmetics costs and building rents for residential educational institutions will now be released every month without delay.

The decision applies to institutions functioning under:

- SC Welfare Department
- ST Welfare Department
- BC Welfare Department
- Minority Welfare Department

Education Department

The government stated that the move was introduced to ensure better facilities and quality educational environment for students from socially and economically weaker sections.

According to officials, delays of 8 to 9 months in releasing funds earlier had created severe management difficulties in residential schools and hostels.

Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president and ex-Telangana IT minister KT Rama Rao (KTR) on Sunday, May 17, demanded the Centre to dismiss Union Minister Bandi Sanjay Kumar from his position over his son Bageerath facing POCSCO charges for allegedly sexually assaulting a girl. KTR sought Kumar's removal stating that it is necessary for an impartial investigation. Bandi Sai Bageerath was shifted to Cherlapalli Central Prison in Hyderabad on Saturday, May 16, after being sent to 14-day judicial

remand by the magistrate. He was arrested near the Telangana Police Academy in Narsingi. Cyberabad Commissioner Ramesh Reddy said that the accused was apprehended while driving a car.

At a party event in LB

Nagar, KTR asked how Bandi Sanjay Kumar's son was allegedly hidden for nine days before surrendering to the police. The BRS leader stated that an impartial investigation is impossible while the Union Minister continues in office. "He re-

marked that perhaps for the first time in India, a situation has arisen where a look-out notice had to be issued against the son of a sitting Union Minister," KTR said, according to a press release from his office. The BRS leader and Sircilla MLA also alleged that the victim's parents themselves were subjected to intimidation and pressure by the Union Minister from the BJP. He accused Bandi Sanjay of personally threatening and harassing the victim's family and also further alleged that Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy attempted to dilute the seriousness of the case.

Telangana awaiting Centre's share for Indiramma housing scheme: Ponguleti

Minister says Telangana has awaited the Centre's contribution since March and may bear the cost if funds are not released within weeks.

Telangana Revenue and Housing Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy on Saturday, May 16, said the state government was awaiting the Centre's share of funds for the Indiramma housing scheme and would bear the financial burden if the amount was not released within the next few weeks. Speaking informally with reporters, the minister said the state had been waiting since March for the Centre to release its contribution of around Rs 1.13 lakh per house under the housing scheme.

He said final bill payments

to beneficiaries had been temporarily withheld in anticipation of Central assistance. Despite repeated representations by chief minister A Revanth Reddy and himself, the Centre had not sanctioned even a single rural house for Telangana so far, he alleged.

3.5 L houses sanctioned in phase 1: Min

The minister said more than 3.5 lakh houses had been sanctioned in the first phase of the Indiramma housing scheme, of which nearly 1.32 lakh houses had already been completed. Another 68,000 to 72,000 houses were expected to reach slab level by the end of June. He said the second phase of the scheme would be

launched by the chief minister in Adilabad on June 2. The government was also considering relaxations in the second phase by extending assistance to partially constructed houses, he added. Ponguleti said the government planned to conduct joint surveys to permanently resolve inter-departmental land disputes and undertake comprehensive surveys in 70 revenue villages in every district. Targeting the previous BRS government led by K Chandrasekhar Rao (KCR), Ponguleti alleged that land prices were increased twice within six months in 2022 in an "unscientific manner".

HC Orders Removal of Encroachments in Baghlingampally Colony

Hyderabad: The Telangana High Court has directed authorities to immediately remove encroachments on roads, parks, pavements and open spaces in the Baghlingampally Housing Board colony in Hyderabad, observing that unchecked illegal occupation and official negligence had turned a well-planned residential area into a "slum-like locality". Justice NV Shraavan Kumar issued the directions while hearing a petition filed by the Saptagiri Enclave Residents Welfare Association and 14 residents of the HIG-2 section of Baghlingampally over alleged road encroachments. The court also ordered an inquiry against officials who allegedly ignored repeated representations over the years and thereby encouraged encroachments through inaction. After examining photographs submitted by the petitioners, the judge observed that the case reflected how official inaction despite repeated complaints had led to the deterioration of a planned colony. Court says unchecked encroachments and official inaction turned planned colony into a slum-like locality; orders immediate clearance of roads and parks.

HIT-AND-RUN ACCIDENT CLAIMS ONE LIFE IN DABEERPURA

A man lost his life in a hit-and-run accident that occurred under the limits of Rein Bazar Police Station on Friday evening. According to police, the incident took place at around 7:20 PM when an unidentified person was driving a Swaraj tractor with an empty trolley bearing registration number TG11T1618 in a rash and negligent manner from Dabeerpura Flyover towards Dabeerpura Darwaza. When the vehicle reached near Habeeb and Sons Exclusive Clothes Store on Dabeerpura Main Road, the tractor allegedly hit an unidentified male pedestrian who was crossing the road from the New Deccan Optical side towards the clothes store. After the accident, the driv-

er reportedly fled the scene without stopping the vehicle. Following information from locals, Rein Bazar Police rushed to the spot and found the injured man lying on the roadside. Upon examination, he was declared dead at the scene. The body was shifted to Osmania General Hospital mortuary for postmortem and identification procedures. Based on a complaint lodged by Abdul Zubair, 31, a resident of Akbar Nagar, Rein Bazar Police registered a case in Crime No. 88/2026 under Section 106(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and launched an investigation. Police said efforts are underway to trace and apprehend the absconding tractor driver involved in the hit-and-run case.

Superstar Rajinikanth on Sunday, May 17, dismissed claims that he was "jealous" of Tamil Nadu Chief Minister C Joseph Vijay and clarified that his recent meeting with DMK president M K Stalin was purely a courtesy visit, with no political motive behind it. Speaking to reporters at his Poes Garden residence, he responded to recent reports and made it clear that the meeting with the former Tamil Nadu CM was not an attempt to hinder Vijay's chief ministerial aspirations or to signal any political realignment. "In

a democracy, victory and defeat are natural. Still, I felt a bit disheartened when Stalin lost here in Kolathur (in the recently held Assembly elections). I met him in a friendly way," he said.

Dismissing allegations of envy toward TVK founder and CM Vijay, Rajinikanth said there is a 25-year age gap between them and praised Vijay's achievements at a young age, stating that they even surpass those of legendary actors-turned-leaders M G Ra-



machandran and N T Rama Rao, who later went on to become CM of Tamil Nadu and undivided Andhra Pradesh, respectively. "I have seen Vi-

jay since he was young. Why would I be jealous if he became CM at such a young age of 52?"

he added. Rajinikanth also congratulated Vijay, whose TVK won 108 seats to form the government with support from the Congress, VCK, Left parties, and IUML after the April 23 elections, defeating the Dravidian majors DMK and AIADMK. SC to hear pleas for reviewing wages of priests, temple staff

New Delhi: The Supreme Court is scheduled to hear on Monday, May 18, a plea to constitute a judicial commission or an expert committee to review the wages and other benefits given to priests, 'sevadars' and temple staff in state-controlled temples. A bench of Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta is likely to hear the PIL filed by advocate Ashwini Upadhyay. The plea further said the continued refusal to meet the minimum wages with the 2026 inflation-adjusted cost of living index has forced the petitioner to seek judicial intervention to prevent the further marginalisation of priests and temple

A video of All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) MLA Majid Hussain is now not available in India, the leader said. The post was on the late-night attack in Hyderabad's Mehdiatnam area, where self-proclaimed cow vigilantes (gau rakshaks) attacked a vehicle alleging that it was transporting cattle for slaughter.

However, their claim fell flat after it was discovered that the container was carrying cardboard material. Frustrated, the gau rakshaks pelted stones at the contain-

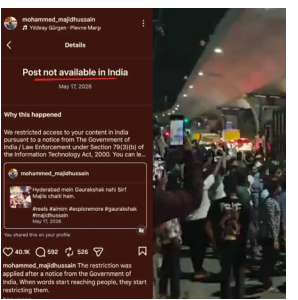
er, following which locals retaliated and chased them away.

The attack took place meters away from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Golconda Zone.

Police rushed in and tried to disperse the angry crowd. At least two policemen and passerby were sustained injuries. Several vehicles were damaged in the incident. MLA Majid Hussain also reached the spot and started a sit-in against police unable to control the communal incident. "When locals were telling the police that it was a plywood-carrying truck and were asking why there was

violence over it. All that the inspector said is that he will do a lathi charge. You could have kept the vehicle near the Asif Nagar police station. What is the use of this useless policing that is helping communal violence?" Hussain had said.

He posted on his social media platforms, including Instagram. However, the post is not available in India, as per Section 79 (3) (b) of the Information Technology Act, which mandates online platforms to remove illegal content when directed by either a court order or a government notification. The AIMIM leader has used

POLITICS OF INTIMIDATION, RISING COMMUNALISM IN INDIA: JAMIAT ULAMA-I-HIND CHIEF

The Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind has expressed serious concern over what it described as "rising communalism", the "silence" of constitutional institutions and an increasing "politics of intimidation" allegedly directed at Muslims and Islamic symbols in the country, calling the current situation "extremely alarming". The remarks were made during the organisation's two-day Working Committee meeting, following which Jamiat chief Arshad Madani shared the declaration adopted at the gathering through a post on X. "For power, a dangerous game is being played with peace and unity,

fuelling religious extremism and hatred while authorities remain silent," Madani said.

Sharing the statement, Madani said, "The current situation in the country, the rising communalism, the silence of constitutional institutions, the increasing measures against Muslims and Islamic symbols, and politics based on hatred are extremely alarming. However, Muslims have never bowed down and

will never bow down. They may bow out of love, but they can never be subdued through force, threats, or oppression." According to the declaration released after the meeting, the organisation alleged that politics rooted in "hatred" has now evolved into a "politics of intimidation", aimed at creating fear among Muslims and forcing them to live under imposed social and political conditions. "For the sake of power, a dangerous game is being played with peace and unity, resulting in a continuous rise in religious extremism and hatred, while the guardians of law remain silent spectators," Madani said while quoting the declaration adopted by the Working Committee.

Gurukul students achieve top ranks in TG EAPCET 2026

Hyderabad: Students from Centres of Excellence operating under Telangana Social Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (TGSWREIS) have achieved top ranks in the Telangana Engineering, Agriculture and Pharmacy Common Entrance Test (TG EAPCET-2026), according to a release on Sunday, May 17. On this occasion, the Minister for SC, ST Welfare Adhuri Laxman Kumar expressed his happiness and said that these results are proof of the exceptional talent that students from poor, Dalit, tribal and backward classes possess. He said that the government is paying special attention to strengthening the Gurukul education system and regularly releasing funds towards quality education, modern facilities, special coaching, digital learning, and competitive exam training for students.

Untimely rains damage crops, lightning strike kills 30 goats in Nagarkurnool

Hyderabad: A shepherd lost 30 goats in one lightning strike on Saturday, May 16, when unseasonal rains in Nagarkurnool district destroyed crops, leaving farmers in distress. The shepherd, from Enabetla village of Kollapur mandal, was given Rs 50,000 by Tourism Minister Jupally Krishna Rao, who also represents the constituency. He visited the agricultural market yard and examined the stacks of wet paddy and maize. He asked the farmers not to worry and assured them that their crops would still be transported to godowns. Cotton, private godowns to be used for storing excess maize. "This year, the maize yield in Telangana increased substantially. To store this excess yield, cotton or private godowns are being utilised. Even function halls will be used for storage," the minister said.

Attacking the Congress party, he

asked why Rahul Gandhi and his party were "feeling the pinch" when illegal Bangladeshi voters were removed during the SIR exercise in West Bengal. "Bangladeshis or Rohingyas, whoever is staying illegally in our country, if their names are found in the voters' list, they should be removed. Though Rahul Gandhi opposes SIR, I have faith in booth-level Congress workers. I request them to cooperate with the EC during SIR to help remove fake votes," Reddy said.

Alleging that Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy did not have trust

in Booth Level Officers (BLOs), the union minister said the CM was politicising the SIR process and speaking in a "provocative manner". Reacting to criticism by the CM over the recent hike in petrol and diesel prices, Reddy said the issue was not under the control of the Central government as it was due to the crisis in West Asia. He further said that when crude oil prices were lower earlier, the Central government had reduced excise duty and requested state governments to cut VAT, which was followed by several states, but not Telangana.

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STAR'S FOUR-FOR, RAHUL-POREL STAND KEEP DELHI ALIVE IN PLAYOFF RACE

New Delhi: Mitchell Starc produced a game-changing four-wicket haul to halt Rajasthan Royals' charge before Delhi Capitals completed a crucial five-wicket win to keep their IPL playoffs hopes alive here on Sunday. Starc's superb 4/40 sparked a dramatic collapse after Rajasthan had stormed to 160 for two in 14 overs, with the visitors eventually managing only 33 runs while losing six wickets to finish at 193 for eight. Delhi then made the chase look comfortable for large parts as KL Rahul (56 off 42) and Abhishek Porel (51 off 31) laid the perfect platform with a 105-run opening stand in just 10.1 overs. While Porel attacked from the outset with seven fours and a six, Rahul paced his innings smartly before falling to Dasun Shanaka. Sahil Parakh chipped in with a quick 9 before skipper Axar Patel provided the finishing flourish with an unbeaten 34 off 18 balls, striking two fours and two sixes.

PAT CUMMINS AND OTHER TOP AUSTRALIA CRICKETERS MAY CHOOSE SA20 OVER BBL DUE TO PAY GAP

Top Australian stars, including Test captain Pat Cummins, could potentially prioritise playing in South Africa's SA20 over the Big Bash League (BBL) in 2028 amid ongoing pay disparity concerns. A report suggests that leading Australian players expect salaries in the range of \$1 million each to remain committed to the BBL. According to The Age, leading Australian fast bowlers, including Cummins, Mitchell Starc and Josh Hazlewood, turned down offers to play in The Hundred later this year, as it would have clashed with a Test series against Bangladesh. The trio would have

earned \$800,000 each if they had accepted the offer for the 27-day tournament. The report adds that earnings for Australian players in global T20 leagues are significantly higher than what they receive for the BBL. Cricket Australia is open to scrapping the BBL draft system, under which overseas players have been handed \$20 million since 2022 — a structure that remains a point of contention. "There's a premium for international players in the BBL — they get about \$100,000 more than the top Australian players. Get rid of that. The safest approach would be to give Suryakumar the leadership for the Ireland and England series and then assess his future

based on his batting performances, but there is no certainty that the selectors will opt for that route now. But Suryakumar's evident struggles with the bat, first during the T20 World Cup and now in IPL 2026, have led some within the decision-making group to feel that the transition process may have to start sooner rather than later. With Suryakumar all set to turn 36 in September, there is a growing feeling among stakeholders that he may no longer fit into India's long-term T20 plans.

RED BULL, FERRARI... MERCEDES NEXT? MAX VERSTAPPEN EYES NÜRBURGRING 24H HISTORY



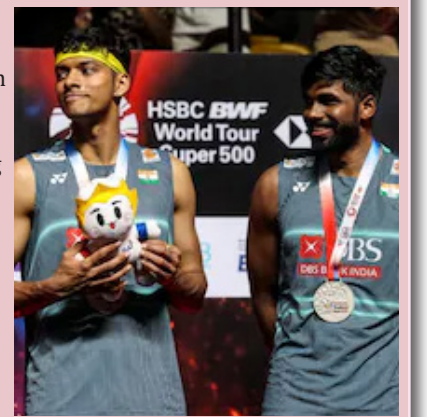
"I don't need to be only an F1 driver, I can also do other things." That was Max Verstappen's message to the motorsport world earlier this year. And now, the four-time Formula 1 world champion stands on the brink of making racing history far beyond the F1 grid. Verstappen is currently competing in the legendary Nürburgring 24 Hours, one of endurance racing's toughest and most unforgiving events. But this isn't just another side quest for the Red Bull ace — a win here would

place him in a unique category of modern motorsport greatness. Verstappen Eyeing Unprecedented History The Dutchman has already won in F1 machinery with Red Bull Racing. He also claimed victory in GT3 competition driving a Ferrari 296 GT3 last year. Now, racing a Mercedes-AMG GT3 at the Nürburgring, Verstappen has the chance to become one of the first modern-era drivers to win races in Red Bull, Ferrari and Mercedes machinery. Wins across different disciplines with three iconic manufacturers, respectively. That's just unheard of. If Verstappen and his team get the job done today, the Dutchman would also become the first F1 driver to win the Nürburgring 24 Hours after securing the World Championship. (Niki Lauda won the event in 1973 BEFORE becoming an F1 champion)

Max's Unquenched Thirst For Verstappen, this growing obsession with endurance racing feels less like a distraction and more like the natural next step. "I've done this already for a while, achieved everything I want to achieve," Verstappen explained recently. "That's why I want to explore other things and I don't want to do them when I'm 40 years old. Now is the perfect age to do it." The 28-year-old has spent months preparing for the challenge, making multiple appearances at the fearsome Nordschleife circuit, nicknamed "The Green Hell" by Jackie Stewart. Now, with teammates Daniel Juncadella, Jules Gounon and Lucas Auer alongside him in the Mercedes-AMG GT3, Verstappen is looking to add yet another extraordinary chapter in his illustrious career so far.

India's Satwik-Chirag Settle For Silver At Thailand Open Final

So close, yet so far for India's star men's doubles pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty. The former world No. 1 duo had to settle for Silver after falling to Indonesia's Leo Rolly Carnando and Daniel Marthin in the men's doubles final of the BWF Thailand Open Super 500 on Sunday. Satwik-Chirag, champions in Bangkok in 2019 and 2024, went down in two straight games of 21-12, 24-23 as the Indonesian pair produced a composed display to clinch the title and register their first-ever win over the Indians. How It Unfolded The opening game was largely one-way traffic. Carnando and Marthin controlled the tempo from the outset, forcing errors out of the Indian duo, who struggled to string together momentum. Satwik-Chirag looked unusually rushed, conceding far too many easy points as the Indonesians cruised through the first game 21-12. The second game, however, finally brought the fight everyone expected. The Indian pair came out sharper and more aggressive, opening up a slender three-point lead before the mid-game interval. But just as they appeared ready to force a decider, the Indonesians clawed their way back, levelling things at 12-12 and setting up a tense finish. From there, the momentum swung wildly. Satwik and Chirag pushed the contest deep into a gripping endgame, eventually dragging the Indonesians into a dramatic tiebreak — which went all the way to 23-23 — where the Indians denied their rivals one championship point after another to keep themselves in the fight.



BCCI Planning To Sack Rishabh Pant As India's Test Vice-Captain: Report

The Board of Control for India (BCCI) is reportedly considering relieving Rishabh Pant of his Test vice-captaincy duties ahead of the one-off red-ball international against Afghanistan next month. According to PTI, the BCCI will have "serious discussions"

about Pant's future when the national selectors meet in Guwahati on Tuesday (May 19) to select Test and ODI squads for the Afghanistan series. The one-off Test will be played between June 6-10, followed by three ODIs on June 14, 17 and 20. The report

said the board has lost confidence in Pant's leadership abilities after his back-to-back poor seasons with the Lucknow Super Giants (LSG) in the IPL. LSG finished seventh in IPL 2025 and is currently tenth in the table in 2026 with only four wins from 12

matches. The report said the BCCI was not too impressed during the Test against South Africa in Guwahati last November, when he had to stand in for regular skipper Shubman Gill, who was injured. The report quoted a BCCI source as say-

ing that there was a concern within Indian cricket's decision-makers about the impact additional responsibility has had on Pant, stressing that the country cannot afford to lose a player capable of changing Test matches with his aggressive batting.

CELTIC CREATE HISTORY, BECOME FIRST FOOTBALL CLUB IN THE WORLD TO...

Celtic FC clinch a record 56th title, snatching the 2025-26 crown from Hearts with late drama and extending Old Firm dominance in Scottish football.

Scottish football club Celtic FC on Saturday, May 16, became the first team to win a whopping 56 titles in a single tournament, as they went past the Rangers to lift the 2025-26 title. They snatched the title from Hearts in the dying minutes of the season, scoring two late goals to earn a 3-1 victory and a 14th title in 15 years.

Needing a victory over the Hearts to usurp the Jambos at the top of the table, Celtic came from behind to deny them a first title in 66 years. Hearts were just minutes away from breaking the dominance that Rangers and Celtic have held over Scottish football for the past 41 years.

Notably, Hearts remained on top of the Scottish Pre-



miership since the start of October, for a whopping 226 days, while Celtic was the top team for just one day.

Derek McInnes' team went ahead in the 43rd minute when Lawrence Shankland headed home from a corner. Celtic rallied to level before the break courtesy of an Arne Engels penalty in stoppage time. Hearts resisted during a

tense second half until three minutes from time, when Daizen Maeda bundled in.

The goal was disallowed for offside, but a VAR review overturned the decision. With Alexander Scholow pushing forward in search of an equaliser, Callum Osmand then walked the ball into the empty net with the final kick of the match.

Celtic fans spilt onto the field in celebration, but it was devastation for Hearts, who have once again fallen at the final hurdle. A 2-0 loss on the final day to Kilmarnock in 1965 saw Hearts lose the league on goal average.

And 21 years later, Hearts were seven minutes away before Albert Kidd struck twice for Dundee and permitted Celtic to snatch the title on goal difference.

Not since Rangers got the better of Aberdeen 35 years ago had the top two faced off for the title on the final day of a Scottish season. Celtic FC clinch a record 56th title, snatching the 2025-26 crown from Hearts with late drama and extending Old Firm dominance in Scottish football.

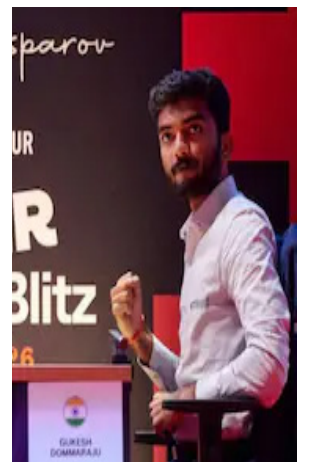
Praggnanandhaa Plays Down Sindarov Hype Ahead Of Gukesh Showdown: 'It's 50-50'

BCCI may strip Rishabh Pant of Test vice captaincy before Afghanistan Test, doubts his leadership and ODI spot after poor IPL form.

Fresh off one of the most dominant Candidates Tournament campaigns in modern chess history, Javokhir Sindarov officially arrived as the newest superstar of the sport — ready to challenge D Gukesh for the crown. But despite all the hype, Indian GM R Praggnanandhaa believes the clash won't be as one-sided as everyone is predicting it to be. Sindarov's Historic Statement Sindarov stamped his authority on the chess world by winning the 2026 Candidates Tournament in Cyprus with a composed final-round draw against Wei Yi. His final score of 10/14 was the highest ever recorded in the modern eight-player double round-robin Candidates format introduced in 2013.

And now, the 20-year-old Uzbek prodigy is heading straight toward a blockbuster World Championship showdown with Gukesh later this year. Indians Hit Back Former world champions Garry Kasparov and Magnus Carlsen have both openly suggested the Uzbek could even start as the favourite against Gukesh in the world title match. But just as the narrative around Sindarov's invincibility began growing louder, he hit a little bump on the road. First, Gukesh himself delivered a huge statement win against the Uzbek at the Grand Chess Tour: Super Rapid and Blitz Poland 2026, reminding everyone that he's still the defending world champion.

Then, Pragg produced a superb performance against Sindarov in Round 2 of the Super Chess Classics in Bucharest last night, handing the Uzbek another defeat and snapping the aura surrounding his unstoppable run in Classical Chess. Pragg Shushes The Hype Despite the growing chatter around Sindarov being the favourite, Praggnanandhaa kept things grounded. "The world championship is six months away. No one knows what form they will go in." Pragg told ChessBase India. "I think it's just 50-50. I don't think anyone is a favourite. It's just about who plays the best at the World Championship that will take it." The upcoming clash between Gukesh and Sindarov



is already shaping up as one of the most fascinating World Championship matches in decades. Both players are just 20 years old, which means chess is about to witness the youngest World Championship match in history

ایجنسی کی رپورٹ کے مطابق، پاکستانی وزیر داخلہ سے ملاقات میں ایرانی پارلیمنٹ کے اسپیکر نے کہا کہ حالیہ واقعات نے ثابت کر دیا ہے کہ خطے میں امریکہ کی موجودگی امن نہیں بلکہ عدم استحکام اور بد امنی کو جنم دیتی ہے۔ انہوں نے ایران کے ساتھ حالیہ کشیدگی کے دوران پاکستان کی حکومت اور عوام کی حمایت پر شکر ادا کرتے ہوئے کہا کہ ایرانی قیادت اور عوام پاکستان کے تعاون کو قدرتی نگاہ سے دیکھتے ہیں، جبکہ بصر انقلاب نے بھی اپنے ابتدائی پیغام میں پاکستان کا خصوصی ذکر کیا تھا۔ قالیباغ نے کہا کہ تھران اور اسلام آباد کے تعلقات اس وقت مثبت سمت میں آگے بڑھ رہے ہیں، تاہم سیاسی، اقتصادی، ثقافتی اور سیکوریٹی تعاون کو مزید وسعت دینے کی ضرورت ہے، جبکہ پارلیمانی روابط کے فروغ پر بھی توجہ دینی چاہی ہے۔ انہوں نے مزید کہا کہ حالیہ جنگ نے واضح کر دیا کہ امریکہ اور اسرائیل خطے کے ممالک کے لیے صرف بحران اور عدم استحکام کا باعث بنتے ہیں، جبکہ خطے کے مسائل کا حل باہمی اعتماد، علاقائی تعاون اور مشترکہ اقتصادی و سیکوریٹی روابط میں پوشیدہ ہے۔ اس موقع پر حسن نقوی نے کہا کہ پاکستان نے اسلام آباد مذاکرات کے دوران ایران کو اپنے قومی مفادات پر مضبوطی سے قائم رہتے ہوئے بھی مسائل کے حل کے لیے پیچیدہ کوششیں کرتے دیکھا۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ پاکستان اور ایران کے عوام پچھلی ایک دوسرے کے قریب تھے، تاہم حالیہ حالات کے بعد دونوں ممالک کے درمیان عوامی سطح پر قربت اور خیرگی میں کمی ملاحظہ ہوا ہے۔
