

IRAN STRONGLY CONDEMNS ISRAEL'S LATEST BLOODY AGGRESSION AGAINST LEBANON



Iran's Foreign Ministry has condemned in the strongest terms Israel's latest aggression against Lebanon, placing a premium on Washington's accountability for the consequences of the regime's war mongering. Israeli warplanes bombed residential areas in southern and eastern Lebanon before dawn Friday. At least 31 Lebanese have been killed as Israel keeps attacking the country despite the US-Iran deal coming into force. ebanon's National News Agency reported that strikes targeted inhabited homes in the towns of al-Sharqiyah, Harouf and Kfar Sir in the Nabatieh district. Earlier strikes on Thursday had

already killed at least three people, including two in Kfar Tibnit and one in Zebdine, according to Lebanese state media. In a statement on Friday, Esmail Baghaei, the Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman, underscored the United States' direct responsibility under the current circumstances. Baghaei highlighted the first point of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) between Iran and the United States which stipulates that an end to Israeli aggression in Lebanon is an inseparable part of the agreement. He warned of the serious and immediate consequences that the continued warmongering of the occupying and genocidal Zionist

regime will have on regional peace and security." "The Islamic Republic of Iran will take all necessary measures to safeguard its interests, security, and rights, as well as those of its allies," he said. The Israeli attacks on Friday targeted sleeping families and marked one of the deadliest single nights since the conflict began on February 28. The death toll from Israel's campaign against Lebanon has now hit the 3,912 mark. More than 11,870 have been wounded, and over 1 million Lebanese displaced, according to official figures.

AI STORM LEAVING MILLIONS OF PEOPLE UNEMPLOYED: TELANGANA CM

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy on Friday, June 19, said that the "AI storm" is leaving millions of people unemployed, and called upon young students educated in social welfare institutions to become doctors, IAS and IPS officers, and political leaders. Addressing a gathering of students at the launch of the distribution of Young India student kits at the LB stadium, the Telangana CM also promised to turn the state into an education and sports hub. Revanth Reddy added that the state government is spending Rs 26,000 crore alone on education. "The establishment of Young India Integrated Res-



budget outlay to education, which Revanth Reddy stated was a good sign of the strengthening of the education sector. The CM stated that the government also launched skill development programmes for the youth to create more blue-collar jobs. "A facility to provide

German and Japanese language teaching programmes alongside English was also created to get the youth jobs abroad. The ITIs have been transformed into ATCs and also established a Skill University with the aim of bringing out talent from the youth and shaping them into skilled manpower," he said.

eyes tourism-led growth, new revenue streams

Hyderabad: Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka on Friday, June 19, said Telangana should focus on sectors capable of generating sustained revenue for the state, stressing that the government's natural and institutional resources should be treated as investments for wealth creation. Bhatti Vikramarka also suggested preparing plans for weekend helicopter tourism and directed officials to explore tourism development projects in Srisaillam and the Nagarjuna Sagar backwaters.

Centre spent Rs 2,586 crore on PM Modi's ads from 2020-26: RTI

Each year, there has been a significant acceleration in the "public money" spent on promoting the Prime Minister.



New Delhi: A right to information reply has revealed that the Centre has spent about Rs 2,586 crore

in advertisements promoting Prime Minister Narendra Modi between 2020 and 2026. To put the amount

into perspective, the total amount spent wasn't just a few hundred crore – it was Rs 25,86,00,00,000, and Indian taxpayers paid for it, according to Trinamool Congress (TMC) MP Saket Gokhale, who filed the RTI. Approximately Rs 936 crore were spent on radio and television advertisements from 2020-2021 to the current financial year.

ISRAEL WILL SOON BE EXPELLED FROM 'EVERY INCH' OF LEBANESE TERRITORY: HEZBOLLAH CHIEF

Hezbollah Secretary-General Naim Qassem has expressed confidence that Israel will be expelled from Lebanese territory as the regime's project to eliminate the resistance group has failed. Addressing the Central Ashura Council ceremony in Beirut on Friday, Sheikh Qassem said that the Israeli regime has failed to defeat the resistance group's "convictions and steadfastness." "The enemy has not defeated our convictions, our steadfastness, our perseverance, or

our continued presence in the field, and we endure all hardships and sanctions." He said that the principles guiding the resistance group "are among the noblest values on earth." "We do not fear death, and this is an essential component of victory," he said, adding that "when the enemy confronts us with weapons, we confront it with weapons." Sheikh Qassem said resistance itself is a form of victory, arguing that "every step in which we reject occupation is a victory." "Even if none of us remained, under the pretext



that there is a threat of death, for us, we are fulfilling our duty, and therefore we do not

fear death." Sheikh Qassem further noted that Hezbollah remains committed to the principles of resistance and the liberation of Lebanese territories occupied by the Is-

raeli regime.

He said that the resistance group has always operated within the framework of Lebanon's constitution and the 1989 Taif Agreement, which ended years of civil war in the country.

The Hezbollah chief said that Israel's efforts to eliminate the resistance had failed and that the regime's forces will ultimately be expelled from all Lebanese territory by the Lebanese people.

"We were born free, and we chose to reject oppression," he added.

Sheikh Qassem also reiterated that "massive losses

are preferable to surrender and defeat." Lebanon is going through "the most dangerous phase," said the Hezbollah chief, adding that the enemy's plan is to eliminate the Resistance and its people, and to eradicate its presence from Lebanon entirely. This is "gravest threat to the future of our homeland," he said.

They sought to close the air, sea, and land crossings in order to prevent the arrival of weapons, technologies, and everything that could strengthen the Resistance and also to prevent reconstruction so that the people would remain displaced and

homeless. The enemy, he maintained, also sought to incite strife between the Army and the Resistance, but the awareness of the Army foiled this plot.

He called upon the Lebanese people "to uphold the principle of religious duty; as for victory, it is in the hands of Allah." Israel and Hezbollah have reportedly agreed to renew a ceasefire on Friday after an escalation in fighting earlier in the day. Citing a senior US official, Reuters reported that the ceasefire would come into effect at around 4 p.m. Lebanon time (1300 GMT).

Iran issues new passage guidelines for ships transiting Strait of Hormuz

Iran has issued a compulsory online clearance system requiring all vessels intending to transit the Strait of Hormuz to register their passage requests through a new centralized online system, effective immediately, as per a newly-linked Islamabad memorandum of understanding between Iran and the United States. The Persian Gulf Strait Authority (PGSA) issued the binding directive on Friday, introducing a 60-day window during which transit fees will be waived by the Iranian government. Under the new protocols, shipping operators must submit their processing requests exclusively via the official PGSA website (PGSA.ir) or through a designated email address (info@PGSA.ir), the PGSA said in a post on its X account.
