IRANIAN OFFICIALS, WORLD LEADERS AND HIGH-RANKING DELEGATIONS PAY TRIBUTE TO MARTYRED LEADER IN TEHRAN

Top Iranian officials, heads of state, foreign dignitaries, and high-ranking delegations from across the world have paid their respects to the martyred Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei. In a solemn and historic ceremony unfolded at Tehran's Grand

Mosalla on Friday, heads of the three branches of the Iranian government along with presidents, parliamentary speakers, special envoys, scholars, religious intellectuals, and thinkers from diverse backgrounds from across the globe paid their respects to the late Ayatollah Khamenei. Iranian officials and their families, representatives of religious minorities, families of martyrs of the resistance front and

Arab tribal leaders also joined the solemn tribute. Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian, Parliament Speaker Mohammad Baqer Qalibaf, Judiciary Chief Gholam-Hossein Mohseni Eje'i and Chairman of Expediency Council Ayatollah Sadeq Amoli Larjani were present in the ceremonies. Parliament speakers of Iraq, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Uzbekistan, Belarus and Kyrgyzstan, foreign ministers of Nicaragua, Congo and Burkina Faso, president of Egypt's Senate, the secretary general of the Palestinian Islamic Jihad resistance movement,

and Omani parliament speaker also paid tribute to the martyred Leader. Secretary General of the Shanghai Cooperation Council Nurlan Yermekbayev, secretary general of the D-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation and deputy secretary general of Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) were among other senior officials who paid their respects to late Ayatollah Khamenei.

IRAN WILL PREVAIL OVER US, MEDVEDEV SAYS AFTER ATTENDING MARTYRED IRANIAN LEADER'S FUNERAL

The visiting deputy chairman of the Russian Security Council, Dmitry Medvedev, has said Iran will prevail over the United States. Medvedev, who heads the delegation attending Iran's martyred Leader's funeral in Tehran, said in a video published on his Telegram channel after attending the funeral on Friday that the Iranian nation will emerge victorious in the struggle against the US. Medvedev said Russia shares the grief of the Iranian people over the martyrdom of Ayatollah Seyed Ali Khamenei. The former Russian president, who is a close ally of Russian Leader Vladimir Putin, said the sorrow stemming from the martyrdom of Ayatollah Khamenei has united the Iranian people. The former president added that the Iranian nation will not yield to pressure from the US and other countries. Medvedev said that on behalf of the leadership and people of the Russian Federation, he expresses the deepest condolences regarding the martyrdom of Ayatollah Khamenei.

INDIAN DELEGATION PAYS TRIBUTE TO LATE IRAN SUPREME LEADER

Tehran: An Indian delegation comprising political leaders, religious figures and civil society representatives paid tribute to Iran's late Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei, on Friday, July 3, ahead of the country's multi-day state funeral programme.

Videos shared by the Embassy of Iran in India on X showed members of the delegation arriving at Tehran's Imam Khomeini Grand Mosalla to pay their respects to the late Iranian leader. India's official delegation, comprising Minister of State for External Affairs Pabitra Margherita

and Bihar Governor Lt Gen (Retd) Syed Ata Hasnain, also travelled to Iran on Friday to attend the funeral ceremonies. The official funeral programme will continue in Tehran on July 4 and 5, culminating in the main funeral procession on July 6.

In an unprecedented move, as many as 23 leaders of major opposition parties, including Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge and Leader

of Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi, have jointly written a letter to Chief Justice of India (CJI) Justice Surya Kant and other judges, raising grave concerns over the alleged manipulation of the country's

electoral process and demanding the immediate suspension of the ongoing voter verification system. The Opposition, comprising the INDIA bloc and other Opposition leaders, said in the letter to the CJI that they chose this unusual path because the core pillars of the republic face severe strain. The primary grievance centres on the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) launched by the Election Commission of India (ECI) to sanitise voter rolls.

DEBT OF RS 8.21 LAKH CRORE INCURRED DURING BRS REGIME: BHATTI

Telangana Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka on Friday, July 3, said a debt of over Rs 8.21 lakh crore was incurred during the previous BRS regime and slammed the party for downplaying it. He also said the BRS is carrying out a Goebels campaign against the Congress government over various issues.

"You (BRS regime) took debts in different ways. (They are) loans under FRBM (Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management) rules, in the name of corporations, pending dues to employees, dues to discoms (power distribu-



tions companies). Altogether, Rs 8,21,651 crore loans, dues you made. Is this not true," he told reporters here. Alleging that it was BRS president K Chandrasekhar Rao who "destroyed" the state when he was the chief minister, he challenged KCR to state whether the debt burden was true or not. KCR must answer the debt burden, he said. BRS working president K

T Rama Rao and party MLA T Harish Rao, who are repeating the same lies every day, should answer whether the state government needs to repay the debts or not, he said.

The Congress government has paid Rs 2.08 lakh crore, including principal and interest, to banks during the last 30 months on the loans taken by the BRS regime, Vikramarka said.

The government got debt restructured as the BRS took loans at the rate of 10 per cent interest and above, he said.

The government has so far got Rs 34,058 crore (payable by 2031-32) restructured to Rs 11,915 crore, he said.
