Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy on Saturday, August 1, said the

state’s per capita income for 2025-26 was Rs 4,18,931 s against Rs 3,80,031 the previous year.The per capita income grew by Rs 38,900 in a single year, which accounts for 10.23 per cent. Telangana is achieving new heights ever since Congress came to power in December, 2023, he said. “We are India’s top-performing state. Our per capita income for 2025-26 is Rs 4,18,931; an increase from Rs 3,80,031 in the last year,” he said in a post on X.The rise in

per capita income became possible through hard work, focus on economic growth, investments, job creation, balanced development across verticals, and a shift from ad hocism to policy-based governance, he said. CHHATTISGARH ANNOUNCES Rs 20 L EX GRATIA FOR KULGAM ATTACK

Raipur: The Chhattisgarh government on Saturday, August 1, announced an ex gratia of Rs 20 lakh each for the families of two migrant workers from the state killed in a terrorist attack in Jammu and Kashmir’s Kulgam district, officials said.

FIRS, DOXXING: HINDUTVA X HANDLES TARGET CJP WOMEN PROTESTERS

YOUNG WOMEN HAVE COME UNDER ATTACK BY FAR-RIGHT-WING AND HINDUTVA SUPPORTERS WHO BELIEVE THEY SHOULD BE “TAUGHT A LESSON.”

Women who participated in the Cockroach Janta Party (CJP) led Jantar Mantar protest in New Delhi are being targeted by several Hindutva social media accounts, revealing their identities and addresses, making them vulnerable targets of both online and offline abuse, including sexual innuendos, reported Young women have come under attack by far-right-wing and Hindutva supporters who believe they should be “taught a lesson” and Parliamentarians like Kangana Ranaut, who called them “Generation Gutter,” for using derogatory language against Prime Minister Narendra Modi.Find her; she has disrespected Prime Minister Modi – was the

caption of Hindutva X handle ‘The Jaipur Dialogues,’ exposing another young woman protestor.In one post, it tagged Delhi Police asking the force to “send her to jail and teach her a lesson”Mr Sinha, a staunch Modi supporter, shared images of two young women asking his followers to post their place of residence, their college or workplace. “Their neighbours, colleagues, and classmates could be informed about their alleged mentality,” read the post. Vikram Pratap Singh, who describes himself as a ‘proud Hindu’ and ‘Modi devotee’ on X, shared an image of girls participating in the protest. CJP spokesperson Ratna Singh told The Wire Hindi



that they are aware of the online harassment and she has endured it too. “We were assured that there would be no harassment of any kind. I am in constant touch with the concerned officials. I have also forwarded copies of the FIR related to the Noida incident to them.”

POLICE COMPLAINTS AGAINST RAHUL GANDHI, PAPPU YADAV OVER ‘HURTING RELIGIOUS SENTIMENTS’

A row erupted after Purnia MP Pappu Yadav came dressed as a monk in the Parliament complex on Friday and enacted the alleged embezzlement of donations made at Ayodhya’s Ram Temple, with several opposition leaders, including LoP Gandhi, playing a cameo role.

Varanasi: Seers and lawyers in Uttar Pradesh, on Saturday, filed police complaints against Lok Sabha Leader of Opposition (LoP) Rahul Gandhi and Independent MP Rajesh Ranjan alias Pappu Yadav, accusing them of hurting religious sentiments after an act over the alleged Ram Temple donation theft was staged at the Parliament premises a day before. A row erupted after Purnia MP Pappu Yadav came dressed as a monk in the Parliament complex on Friday and enacted the alleged embezzlement of donations made at Ayodhya’s Ram Temple, with several opposition leaders, includ-

ing LoP Gandhi, playing a cameo role. One of the complaints was filed by seers at Varanasi’s Kotwali police station while the other was submitted by lawyers. Both the complaints accused the Parliamentarians of hurting religious sentiments of the Hindus. Speaking to IANS, Patalpuri Math head priest Jagadguru Balak Das Devacharya said: “Through the act carried out by Pappu Yadav outside the Parliament House, he has insulted the saffron robe, the saint community, and also Lord Ram. A complaint has been lodged against all the opposition leaders involved... A demand has

been made that legal action be taken against them otherwise the seer community will stage large-scale protests.” Gaurav Banswal, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Kashi Zone), said: “... Some videos have surfaced on social media which show MP Rajesh Ranjan dressed up as a monk while being engaged (in an act) at the Parliament premises. They (seers) have submitted a written complaint against the act alleging that religious sentiments have been hurt.”“For now, the complaint consists the name of Rajesh Ranjan alias Pappu Yadav,” the DCP added. Meanwhile, lawyers in Vara-



nasi staged a protest against Pappu Yadav over the temple donation theft act. Moreover, they also submitted a written complaint and demanded legal action against the Purnia MP Pappu Yadav and Lok Sabha LoP

Rahul Gandhi. Meanwhile, seers and several Hindu outfits, including the Vishva Hindu Parishad, held demonstrations in various parts of the country against Pappu Yadav for “insulting Sanatan Dharma”.

PM MODI FORGIVES YOUTH OVER ABUSIVE SLOGANS, CALLS FOR GUIDANCE INSTEAD OF PUNISHMENT

Addressing the issue, the Prime Minister said he had forgiven the youngsters who used objectionable language against him, describing them as “misguided” rather than malicious.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday struck a conciliatory note over the recent controversy surrounding abusive slogans raised against him during the student protests over the alleged NEET paper leak, saying that the youth should be guided rather than punished. Addressing the issue, the Prime Minister said he had forgiven the youngsters who used objectionable language against him, describing them as “misguided” rather than malicious. “I forgive the youth who abused me. Some youngsters have lost their way. We cannot change them through punishment. What they need is guidance,” PM Modi said. Referring to the incident at Jantar Mantar, where some protesters allegedly raised abusive slogans against him and his late mother, the Prime Minister said the entire nation had witnessed what happened. “The whole world saw what happened at Jantar Mantar. Some angry children abused me and even my mother. I forgive them,”



he remarked. Using a heartfelt analogy, PM Modi urged society to respond with compassion instead of anger. “Sometimes the tongue slips between our teeth and bleeds. But the teeth are ours, and the tongue is ours. In the same way, these children are our own,” he said. The Prime Minister stressed that society has a responsibility to show young people the right path instead of subjecting them to harsh punishment or prolonged legal action. His remarks come amid an ongoing controversy over abusive slogans raised during student demonstrations demanding action

over the NEET paper leak issue. Earlier, a girl booked over objectionable remarks against the Prime Minister also released a public apology video, expressing regret and seeking forgiveness. EXCISE DEPT SEIZE 55 SMUGGLED LIQUOR BOTTLES NEAR PAHADISHAREEF



The Excise Special Task Force (STF) of the Prohibition and Excise Department seized 55 bottles of Goa liquor during a vehicle-checking drive near Hyderabad’s Pahadishareef on Saturday, August 1. On a tip-off that liquor bottles were being transported from Goa via Hyderabad Airport (Rajiv Gandhi International Airport), Shamshabad, into the city in violation of excise regulations.During the operation, the teams intercepted a vehicle and seized 55 bottles of Goa liquor. The seized liquor was handed over to the Excise Station, Shamshabad, for further legal action.Investigation is underway to identify those involved in the illegal transportation.

‘Playing victim card,’ Cong slams PM for ‘forgiving’ protesters

New Delhi: The Congress on Saturday, August 1, said that PM Narendra Modi is playing the victim card by saying he has forgiven the youth who abused him and demanded an apology from him for the “brutality” unleashed on student protesters and the trauma they suffered due to NEET paper leaks. The Opposition party also claimed that the prime minister’s “Instagram sabhas,” which it termed an act of “supreme self-obsession,” are fooling no one. “Late last night, in an act of supreme self-obsession, the prime minister said that



he forgave our youth. This is an insult to the nation and to our youth, which has suffered under his government and is legitimately demanding an apology from him. The prime minister’s InstaGram Sabhas are fooling

no one,” Congress general secretary Jairam Ramesh said in a post on X. In an Instagram video posted on Friday night, Modi said it pained him that even his late mother was subjected to “filthy abuses” at the Jantar

Mantar and lamented that “our daughters” had used such language, even as he called for forgiving the “misguided children”. The Prime Minister said he could understand the anguish prevailing in society but stressed that this was the time to embrace the youth and guide them on the right path. In his post, Ramesh said, “The self-declared non-biological PM enjoys playing the victim card.”The Congress leader also said that Modi uses “vile vitriol” against his predecessors and political opponents. STALIN QUESTIONS CM VIJAY’S SILENCE OVER ALLEGED CUSTODIAL DEATH, DEMANDS ACCOUNTABILITY

Chennai: DMK president M.K. Stalin has strongly criticised the Tamil Nadu government over the death of a 24-year-old man from Thoothukudi, alleging that the incident reflects a disturbing pattern of custodial deaths in the State.



He questioned when Chief Minister C. Joseph Vijay would respond to the recurring incidents and accused the government of failing to show accountability or compassion.

The criticism follows the death of Arunachalam, a resident of Amudha Nagar in Thoothukudi district, who died while undergoing treat-

ment at the Government Medical College Hospital after allegedly sustaining injuries during police custody. According to available information, Arunachalam was arrested by the police on July 17 on charges of selling liquor illegally in the black market. Following his death, members of his family alleged that he had been assaulted by police personnel during custody and claimed that the injuries he sustained led to his death.
