TELANGANA SIR 460 POLLING STATIONS ADDED AFTER RATIONALISATION

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After the enumeration phase of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls ended on August 10, the Telangana Chief Electoral Officer published a list of the rationalised polling stations on Wednesday, August 12. Before rationalisation, Telangana had 35,985 polling stations across 119 Assembly constituencies. The number

has now jumped to 36,353 polling stations. A total of 460 stations are proposed to be added, even as 92 are being deleted/merged. As many as 551 stations will be changed to a different location, and 335 will be given a different name. Hyderabad now has 4,094 polling stations from the previous 4,062. As many as 32 stations are being added, 117 are changing locations, and 43 are being given different names.

AASARA PENSIONS NEW AASARA PENSIONS ANNOUNCED, APPLICATIONS OPEN TILL AUGUST 31

The Telangana Government has initiated steps to sanction new pensions under the Cheyutha Social Security Pension Scheme, with the objective of providing social security to eligible poor and vulnerable sections of society. In the first phase, new pensions will be sanctioned to single women, widows, persons with disabilities, toddy tappers, handloom workers, filariasis patients, and persons suffering from blood-related disorders such as

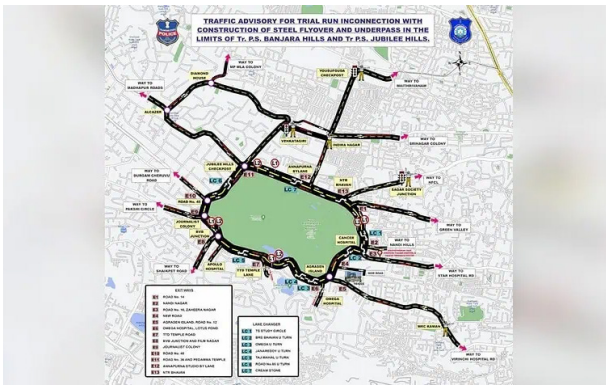
thalassemia, sickle cell disease and haemophilia. Applications already received during the Praja Palana programmes, 99-day progress plan Gram Sabhas and Prajavani will also be considered. Those who had applied earlier and submitted all the required documents need not apply again. However, those who had not submitted the required documents, as well as eligible persons who have not applied so far, can submit fresh applications.

As the one-way system around the Kasu Brahmananda Reddy National Park (KBR Park) comes into force from August 18, the Hyderabad Traffic Police have released an advisory that will remain in force for 1.5 years. This comes in view of ongoing construction of flyovers and underpasses under the Hyderabad City Innovative and Transformative Infrastructure (H-CITI) Project. It is being introduced to facilitate the construction of seven flyovers and underpasses around KBR Park. NFCL to Road No 45/IT Corridor/Cable Bridge



There is no direct right turn at NTR Bhavan. Commuters must turn left toward KBR Park and use either the left or right lanes to proceed toward Road No 45 or route through Journalist Colony. KBR Checkpost to NFCL/ Panjagutta/Begumpet

Commuters can use both lanes from the KBR Checkpost. Those heading toward NFCL/Panjagutta must switch to Lane 1 (the leftmost lane) via the newly opened median near the Gymkhana Club and take a free left turn at NTR Bhavan. KBR Checkpost to Road

No 10/Road No 12/Cancer Hospital. Commuters can switch to the left lane via the median opening near Study Circle to access Road No 10. Those travelling to Road No 12 can move left after passing the Cancer Hospital. NFCL to Road No 36 Right turn to the NTR Bhavan is closed. Commuters can take an alternative route by turning right at Srinagar Colony T-Junction toward Indiranagar Gadda, Venkatagiri Cross Roads, Road No 10 Jubilee Hills (Diamond House), and then a right turn at the newly opened median near Alcazar Plaza. Film Nagar Access in the evening This comes in view of ongoing construction

of flyovers and underpasses under the Hyderabad City Innovative and Transformative Infrastructure (H-CITI) Project. Turning right from Road No 45 is restricted. Commuters heading to Film Nagar can use Road No 51 and Road No 52. More on KBR one-way traffic route Briefing the media, Joint Commissioner of Police (Traffic) D Joel Davis said foundation and pillar work has already begun for 17 pillars along Road No 2 in Banjara Hills and the stretch between KBR Park and the Checkpost, where traffic disruption was relatively minimal. "Around 110 more pillars, along with underpasses, are yet to be constructed,"

NO FREEDOM FIGHTERS IN TELANGANA? RAJA SINGH OPPOSES TRUMP TOWERS

Hyderabad: Goshamahal MLA T Raja Singh objected to the proposed Trump Towers in Kokapet, claiming it raises serious questions about the "priorities and values" of the Telangana government. In a statement released on Wednesday, August 12, Singh said he was apprehensive about "promoting" United States President Donald Trump through a major tower project in Hyderabad. "I want to ask Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy this: Is Telangana so short of inspirational personalities that we have to glorify the name of a foreign political leader when our own soil has produced countless freedom fighters and national heroes who sacrificed their lives for India?" Singh said. Slamming the Congress government, the former Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader said the country achieved freedom because of the nation's ultimate sacrifice and cannot be attributed to businessmen, celebrities, or foreign political leaders.

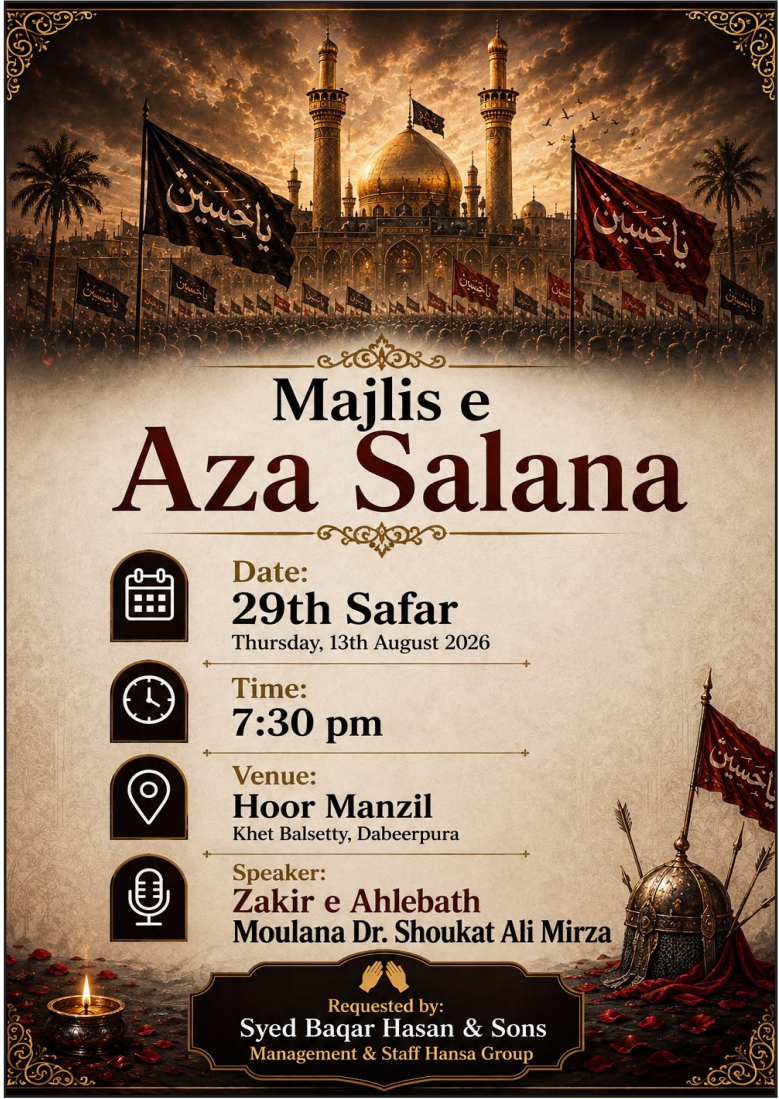
HC hears pleas against Speaker's order on BRS defected MLAs

The Telangana High Court on Wednesday, August 12, commenced hearing petitions against the Assembly Speaker's decision dismissing the disqualification of 10 Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) MLAs who defected to Congress after the 2023 Assembly Elections. A two-judge division bench of Chief Justice Aparesh Kumar Singh and Justice

GM Mohiuddin will hear the petition, to continue the following day. According to BRS counsels, Speaker Gaddam Prasad Kumar's dismissal decision is "perverse, unsustainable and unconstitutional." They argued that Khairatabad MLA Danam Nagender, who was elected to the Assembly on a BRS ticket, voluntarily gave up his party membership by contesting the 2024 Lok Sabha election on a Congress

ticket, thereby attracting disqualification. According to BRS counsels, Speaker Gaddam Prasad Kumar's dismissal decision is "perverse, unsustainable and unconstitutional." Calling the Speaker's decision an "imaginary interpretation," the counsels said, "Under the Tenth Schedule, the moment anybody contests from another party, they attract disqualification, without requiring any further evidence.

GLOBAL AI KNOWLEDGE PLATFORM LAUNCHED IN HYDERABAD

A digital platform intended to bring together researchers, technology experts, entrepreneurs and policymakers working in artificial intelligence (AI) was launched here on Wednesday, August 12, by Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president KT Rama Rao (KTR).

The platform, called "AI Hub Switzerland," has been developed as a comprehensive AI reference layer to address the information overload created by the thousands of new AI tools, research papers, standards and regulatory guidelines emerging every day, according to a statement by its founder Sridhar Gande. Rather than functioning merely as a directory of AI tools, the platform seeks to offer startups, enterprises, researchers and AI professionals knowledge and compliance-related information in a single place, the statement said.
